





TOUR TO ENGLAND, SCOTLAND & WALES

September 9-22, 2015

Day 1 - Sep. 9: Depart U.S.A


Depart the United States on your overnight flight to London.

Day 2 - Sep. 10: Arrive London

Upon arrival in London you will be met at the airport by your local tour manager. After boarding your coach you will depart London and drive to visit Windsor Castle in the English county of Berkshire. The original castle was built in the 11th century after the Norman invasion by William the Conqueror and since the time of Henry I, it has been used by succeeding monarchs and is the longest-occupied palace in Europe. After visiting the castle we will proceed to our hotel in London for check-in.

Day 3 - Sep. 11: London / Stratford-upon-Avon / Coventry / Leeds

This morning we will depart London and drive to Shakespeare's Stratford-upon-Avon where you will take your pictures of Anne Hathaway's Cottage, then retrace the footsteps of the famous playwright at your own pace in this famous market town. After lunch, visit Coventry, whose center had to be rebuilt after the devastation of World War II bombings, and hear the tale of Lady Godiva and Peeping Tom before stopping to admire the splendid modern cathedral. Finally, head northwards out of the Midlands to Leeds for overnight.



Day 4 - Sep. 12: Leeds / York / Jedburgh / Edinburgh

Today begins with a visit to York, one of England's finest and most beautiful historic cities. Here you will stand in awe before the great structure of York Minster, then follow your Tour Director through a maze of quaint streets within England's most well-preserved and complete medieval city, including the narrow Shambles. Continue onwards through wild Northumberland National Park and see a section of Hadrian's Wall, the famous Roman coast-to-coast defense against marauding northern tribes. Then, after crossing the Scottish border, at Jedburgh you will take a moment to capture pictures of the house of Mary, Queen of Scots, and see the abbey ruins. Afterwards you will continue on for a late-afternoon arrival in Edinburgh. This evening enjoy a traditional Scottish night out with Highland dancers, bagpipers, and, of course, the Ceremony of the Haggis.

Day 5 - Sep. 13: Edinburgh

Today you have a full day to explore the Scottish capital. Morning sightseeing with a Local Guide introduces you to the 200-year-old "New Town" and famous scientists, inventors, and novelists. In the "Old Town," drive up the narrow Royal Mile to explore Edinburgh Castle, where you will admire Scotland's Crown Jewels, the oldest set of crown jewels in the British Isles. In the afternoon board the former Royal Yacht Britannia, which for the Queen was once the perfect royal residence for glittering state visits and family holidays. Tour five decks and see how the Royal Family and crew of 240 lived and worked on board.



Day 6 - Sep. 14: Edinburgh / St. Andrews / Pitlochry / Newtonmore

A day of memorable sightseeing: take the elegant Forth Road Bridge to St. Andrews, whose Royal and Ancient Golf Club has given us the rules of golfing, for an orientation tour. Then cross the Firth of Tay and via Dundee and Perth, head into the rich heritage and culture of the Highlands, with a stop in the Victorian mountain resort of Pitlochry. Spend the night in the lovely village Newtonmore, situated in Britain's largest national park, the Cairngorms.

Day 7 - Sep. 15: Newtonmore / Culloden Moor / Inverness / Fort William / Glasgow

Via the battlefield of Culloden Moor and Inverness, the Highland capital, skirt Loch Ness as you drive to Fort William beneath Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain. Enter haunting Glen Coe, where the MacDonald Clan was massacred in 1692, pass wild Rannoch Moor, and then drive along the "Bonnie Banks" of Loch Lomond to Glasgow. (B/D)

Day 8 - Sep. 16: Glasgow / Gretna Green / Lake District / Liverpool

Today begins by heading south through the history-steeped Lowland Hills and a visit to Gretna Green, where the blacksmith used to wed runaway couples. Drive through beautiful scenery in the Lake District, considered to be the finest of England's national parks. Nestled at the foot of breathtaking fells, you will visit Wordsworth's Grasmere, before following along the spectacular shores of Lake Windermere – England's largest lake. Your driver will make

a brief stop in on the banks of Windermere for you to capture photos of the quaint historical fishing village of Bowness. End the day in Liverpool, of Beatles fame, and once the departure port of the great transatlantic liners.

Day 9 - Sep. 17: Liverpool / North Wales Excursion / Liverpool

Today is dedicated to the haunting beauty of mountainous North Wales. After a stop in the beautiful village Betws-y-Coed, drive over the spectacular Llanberis Pass and through Snowdonia National Park, watching the landscape rise and fall in a dramatic tug-of-war between soaring mountains, plunging valleys, surging rivers, and silent glacial lakes along the way. You will pause briefly in Caernarvon, where the castle saw the investiture of Charles as Prince of Wales. Then, follow the coast road via the walled town of Conwy on the way back to our hotel in Liverpool.

Day 10 - Sep. 18: Liverpool / Chester / Ludlow / Cardiff

Today you will do a walking tour of Chester, a classic county town on the Dee River bursting at the seams with 2000 years of history and culture. Your walking tour takes you back in time as you visit the impressive Roman remains and meander through streets of black and white half-timbered buildings and the two-tiered arcades called the "Rows." Pause in the pretty market town of Ludlow before heading back into Wales and Brecon Beacons National Park, land of salmon rivers and the Welsh mountain pony. Finally, through "The Valleys," whose iron ore and coal were the raw materials for the Industrial Revolution, you will arrive in the Welsh capital. Here, an orientation drive introduces you to the major attractions: Cardiff Castle, Cathays Park, Millennium Stadium, and the stately civic buildings.

Day 11 - Sep. 19: Cardiff / Bath / Glastonbury / Bristol

Leaving Wales, cross the Severn Bridge for an orientation tour of the elegant Georgian city of Bath, famed for its Roman relics. In the afternoon you will head into the romantically scenic West Country and Glastonbury with its King Arthur associations. You will enjoy an orientation tour of this historic market town before continuing onwards to Bristol.



Day 12 - Sep. 20: Bristol / Stonehenge / London

Drive Bristol and drive to visit prehistoric Stonehenge. First, explore the stunning new visitor center with its imaginative exhibitions, then admire the magnificence of the monument from up close. You will return to London in the afternoon and check into your hotel for overnight.



Day 13 - Sep. 21: London

Today the city of London is yours to discover! Our local expert guide will take you on a sightseeing tour of the city's famous landmarks: The Houses of Parliament and Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Whitehall's mounted Horse Guards and the Prime Minister's Downing Street, Piccadilly Circus, and Buckingham Palace. Highlights include a visit to St. Paul's Cathedral and the ceremonial pageantry of the Changing of the Guard (if held) and the Tower of London with its spectacular Crown Jewels.

Day 14 - Sep. 22: London / U.S.A.

This morning you will bid a fond farewell to the UK after breakfast.

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, <u>provided</u> the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. Travel Documents: A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U. S. citizens. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to the countries being visited on this tour. If you are not a U. S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. George's International is not responsible for visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 25 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on Virgin Atlantic (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing. Fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.
