

Family Promise Volunteer Opportunities

Resurrection Lutheran Church will be hosting Family Promise guests October 18-25 and November 15 – 29, 2015.

Each host week, we will need approximately 30-50 volunteers to make this program run smoothly. Volunteers can come from within our congregation and school, as well as from support congregations, like St. James Catholic Church. The hope is that our volunteers will be of all ages and that individuals, families and church groups will serve together.

- 1. Lunch/Snack Provider (1-2 volunteers) Sunday by 5:30 pm** Provide food items for the guests to prepare their own lunches/snacks for the entire week. Sandwich bread, meat, cheese, whole fruit, individually packaged snacks/chips, etc.
- 2. Sunday Afternoon Setup (1-4 volunteers) 4:45-5:30 pm** Setup beds, tables, room dividers, etc. for the guests.
- 3. Evening Host (2 volunteers) 5:30–8:30 pm** Greet the guests, provide hospitality, help children with activities and homework, etc. Families are encouraged to bring your children.
- 4. Dinner Host/Provider (2-3 volunteers) 6:00-8:30 pm** Provide a nutritious meal for up to 14 people at 6:30 pm. Stay and enjoy the meal with the guests. Note: Resurrection Lutheran Church has a full kitchen, but preparing the meal ahead of time is recommended.
- 5. Overnight Host (1 male & 1 female volunteers) 8:30 pm-7:30 am** We require one male and one female host to sleep overnight and stay until 7:30 am. Responsible for helping guests with any overnight issues. Arrive by 8:30 pm or earlier to relieve the Evening Host. (Families are welcome to serve together.)
- 6. Breakfast Setup/Provider (1 volunteer) 5:40–6:40 am** Provide and serve a simple breakfast for up to 14 people at 6 am (cereal, fresh fruit, muffins or bagels and coffee and juice). Volunteer may also be the Overnight Host, or may deliver food the night before for the Overnight Host to serve in the morning. (Saturday & Sunday breakfast time could be later.)
- 7. Sunday Morning Cleanup (1-4 volunteers) 7:30-8:00 am** Clean up - gather bed linens, take down beds, room dividers, tables, etc.
- 8. Launder Bedding/Towels (1 volunteer) Sunday 8:00 am** Take bedding & towels to launder them & return them to the Resurrection Lutheran Church.

Please ask God to show you where you are called to serve.
