Pastor's Corner

Dear Friends and Family,

The Pastoral Council met last week for their monthly meeting. Among the items discussed were:

- **Together in Mission** campaign. The final total received for 2017 was \$130, 906. Our goal was \$121,500. The Council confirmed that since the money was given for helping our poorest parishes, we would honor the amount over--\$9,406, which is being returned to St. James, by giving it to our Sister Parish, San Miguel in Watts. We sincerely thank everyone who supported the 2017 Campaign and helped us to reach our goal. We ask your generous pledge now for the 2018 Campaign—envelopes are in the pews.
- The Council reviewed the **100th Anniversary Mass of St. James School** on January 28th and we were very happy with the Mass attendance by families and graduates and the over 600 visitors to the school for their lunch and Open House.
- The position for our **new School Principal** is listed on a number of websites and applications are being received by the Archdiocese. Our search committee is being formed and the Council gave recommendations of possible members for the committee. They will be ready to begin interviews soon.
- Our multi-parish **Dive-In Faith Formation** Series will be in the evenings from March 5-22. We will host six of the 24 sessions at our O'Gorman Center and the other sessions will be at other nearby parishes. Flyers are at the church doors, website and on page 3. The Council encourages parishioner participation in these wonderful sessions.
- The replacement of the doors of the church and protective canopy (officially called our Architectural Entry Feature) was reviewed. It is on track and in final stages for City approval. Our hope is to begin construction soon after Easter. (At left, an inspection hole was dug to check the proposed attachment to the foundation for the building permit.)
- Finally, the Pastoral Council made preparations for hosting Coffee and Doughnuts after the 8 am and 10 am Masses this Sunday and are looking forward to meeting many of their fellow parishioners.



As we journey together through this Lenten Season, I encourage you to look to the cross and consider the unconditional love God has for each and every one of us.

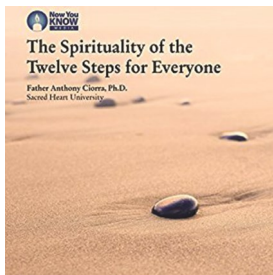

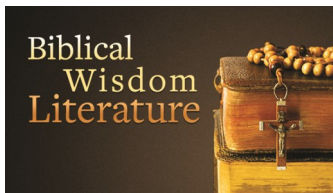

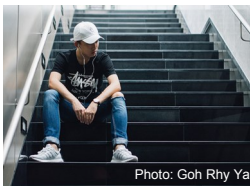

Catholic Q & A

Q: We've touched on the sacraments of Baptism and Matrimony. How does the Catechism Of The Catholic Church describe Confirmation?

A: Confirmation is one of the three sacraments of Christian initiation, along with Baptism and the Eucharist. These three sacraments lay the foundations of every Christian life. "Like the origin, development, and nourishing of natural life, the faithful are born anew by Baptism, strengthened by the sacrament of Confirmation, and receive in the Eucharist the food of eternal life."

*Confirmation perfects Baptismal grace.

*Confirmation imprints a spiritual mark on the Christian's soul.

*Confirmation strengthens our bond with the Church and her mission.

Read about Confirmation in your catechism, including the state of preparatory grace, the sacred chrism, the laying on of hands, and the words: "Accipe signaculum doni Spiritus Sancti"(Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit.) See the glory of God. Find insight and inspiration in your catechism. Know your faith.

If you are a parent, volunteer, or staff for St. James Church or School, you are required to take a VIRTUS class to maintain a professional relationship with minors whether on or off the parish or school premises.

If you have already taken a VIRTUS class, please check your current VIRTUS certificate for the expiration date **(which is valid for four years from the day you attended class)**.

There is a two week grace period to renew your certificate by taking the "Keeping the Promise Alive" recertification class. After the grace period, you will be required to take "Protecting God's Children", the original class. **Parish Office at 310.372.5228.**

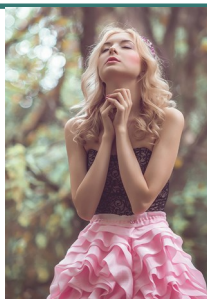

Gospel Reflection

Why do we always go to the desert?

We see this example in Scripture time and time again. The Israelites wandered in the desert. King David and prophets were driven into the wilderness. And now Jesus is in the same place. Lent after Lent, we too are invited into a barren, desolate place. Why do we always go to the desert?



Throughout Scripture, the desert is a place of testing. It's also a place of hiding and withdrawal. In the Old Testament, David fled into the wilderness to hide from Saul, Elijah from Jezebel, and Jonah from God! In other words, the desert is a place of "retreat." In Christian circles, we use the word to describe a spiritual weekend away. But its meaning comes from warfare, as we well know. To retreat means to draw back, to separate oneself from the fighting. Of course, a military retreat brings its own kind of "battle" -- the internal assessment of why the fighting went so poorly.

As we enter into this Lenten season, we are invited to retreat into the desert with Jesus. Attending a day or weekend of reflection is a wonderful spiritual practice. This "desert spirituality," however, can fill all forty days. We can fulfill our Lenten resolutions with a purpose -- writing daily notes to family and friends can inspire new gratitude, every time we pass up that specific food item can be cause for intercession for deeper sufferings and privations of others.

The Gospel tells us that "the Spirit drove him out into the desert." In other words, God wants us to be here. What feels uncomfortable is actually part of our spiritual journey. To be stretched, to be challenged, to confront our own areas of weakness -- these things are essential in our walk with God. This Lent, will you go to the desert?

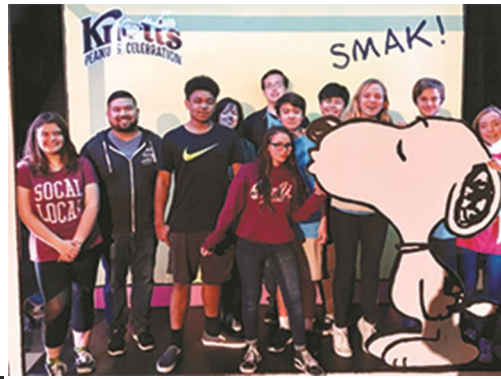

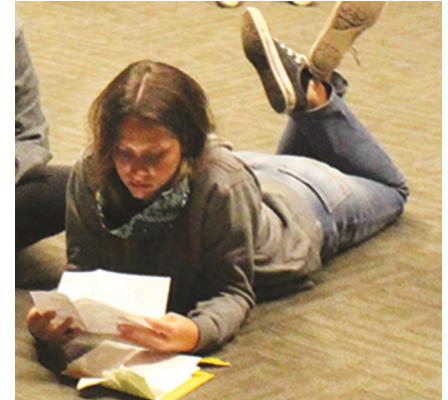
