Q&A

Q: We are more than nine weeks beyond Easter, but remember that Ordinary Time doesn't mean common or unexceptional, or of no special quality or interest, rather it is Church time; weeks that are ordered, numbered, governed. In these weeks we may consider and reflect about what the Catechism tells us about the meaning and definitely exceptional saving significance of the Resurrection. The Pascal mystery has two aspects. What are they?

A: By his death, Christ liberates us from sin. By his Resurrection, he opens for us the way to a new life. Read about Easter as the historical and transcendent event that is the crowning truth of our faith in Christ. Read your catechism.

To the Parents of Young Children:

May we suggest...

Relax, God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome! Sit towards the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of other's heads. Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and action of the priest, altar servers, choir, etc. Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you. Soon, we will offer some children's religious books that they can use while in Mass. If you have to leave Mass with your child, please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." Remember that the way we welcome children in the Church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God and to one another. Let them know they are at home in this house of worship.

DID YOU KNOW

Protect kids from bullying while playing online

The pace of online gaming is only growing. There is a small but real chance that victimization could occur when kids play and interact with others on phones, tablets, laptops, desktops and gaming consoles. A helpful way to teach children about handling problems is to encourage them to report issues when they arise. Internet service providers and gaming networks have systems set up to field complaints of abuse and then investigate them (in conjunction with law enforcement, when necessary).
