Everyday Discipleship

In *Everyday Discipleship*, Tracy Welliver describes six basic traits of disciples of Jesus: Mindful, Prayerful, Grateful, Gracious, Committed and Accountable. Today we'll talk about being Grateful.

"How can one acknowledge the presence of God throughout all aspects of life and not give thanks? The sheer magnitude of the gift of life and all in it should move us to gratitude. Unfortunately, we too often forget to be grateful because of selfishness, self-centeredness, or not being mindful of the reality of our situation. But not only should we give thanks, we are called to give thanks.

Thanksgiving changes us. Elie Wiesel has said, "For me, every hour is grace. And I feel gratitude in my heart each time I can meet someone and look at his or her smile." He survived concentration camp! For Christians, being grateful allows others to see more clearly a joy of the Lord in us. When we focus on our blessings and constantly give thanks for them, we become transformed.

In stewardship, we are called to receive all from God with a grateful heart. We often hear the slogan, "An Attitude of Gratitude." The key here is to be grateful for the little things along the way along with the obvious gifts we receive. Be thankful for the hands that touch a loved one's face, the gift of music we hear on the car radio, and the bees that fly around our head because they pollenate the earth around us. Don't let a day go by without finding things for which to give thanks to God. God calls you to gratefulness, not because he needs your thanks, but because of the transformative power of being grateful."

Inspiration for the Week

In today's competitive world, many people do not see justice and humility as virtues to acquire. Yet Jesus makes a big point of giving us the beatitudes as the blueprint to follow for our lives. Being poor in spirit, meek, thirsting and hungering for righteousness, being merciful, clean of heart, and peacemakers are all hallmarks of the true disciple and a child of God. After doing all these things, however, the true disciple must be prepared for persecution. Are you really ready to become a true disciple?

Gospel Meditation

"Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven." Here, in a nutshell, is the Christian belief about the afterlife. We trust that heaven is open to believers who accept the gift of salvation and follow the way of the Lord, even (or especially) when that way is difficult!

The beatitudes in today's Gospel give us a program for following the path to heaven. These famous words offer a kind of twofold image. There are, on the one hand, the beatitudes about what we should do and be: poor in spirit, meek, merciful, clean of heart, and peacemakers. Such qualities are reflections of the nature of God in whose image we are meant to live. When we embrace and reflect this image to the world, there is no doubt we are walking on the path of God's will.

Then, there are also the beatitudes about what we are called to endure: mourning, hunger for righteousness, persecutions and insults due to our belief in Jesus. These are the trials that often beset the life of a faithful Christian--admittedly more so in some ages and areas than in others. But Jesus makes it clear that even these trials and struggles are a sign that a Christian is on the right path, not that God has abandoned him or her, but that the reward of heaven lies around the corner.

One of the greatest consolations of our faith is that even when life does not unfold according to our own perfect designs, even when there is suffering to deal with, even when we do not have great success in the eyes of the world, we can maintain hope and peace as we await the "reward" of the just. The eternal happiness of heaven will be worth every ounce of temporary trial here on earth.

And I am rich enough
And ask for nothing more.
Amen.





Would you like your children to learn about God's love for them?

Would you like them to be familiar with favorite old and new testament **bible stories?**

Did you know that St. James offers **Sunday School during the 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. Masses?**

Our Sunday School program helps the **3, 4 and 5 & 6 (kindergarten) year – old child** develop a foundation of faith by helping them to know God through the **gifts He has given us.**

Our **developmentally appropriate** lessons are based on bible stories. Each week the lesson is sent home so that you may go over it again within the family setting.

The children are provided a binder for the lesson sheets, thereby **creating a bible storybook** to have at home.

At Sunday School, **children meet other children**, play games, sing songs, learn prayers and bible stories and engage in creative activities that enhance the lesson.

They have a **simple snack** and some special celebrations and participate in the mass at **Thanksgiving and Christmas.**

Parents have the opportunity to **participate** in various ways, but can also enjoy Mass and know that their **children are safe and happy** participating in a faith experience created just for them!

Sunday School is held in the **preschool classrooms**. To be eligible for Sunday School, children must be potty-trained and **3 years old by Sept. 1st.**



St. James Preschool is a Catholic-Christian preschool that provides opportunities for each child to grow socially, physically, cognitively and spiritually. We believe in creating a warm and loving environment where children can learn about themselves, gain an understanding of others and develop strong self-esteem.

The preschool has four classrooms available. The classes are for potty-trained children who are 2 ½ to 5 years old. Pre-K applicants must be four years old by September 1st to be eligible for our Pre-K program, but not 5 years old by September 1st.

At St. James Preschool the children are given many opportunities to develop literacy skills and reading readiness. Each month the children participate in a **Book Swap** where they bring "old" books from home to swap for "new" books for their home libraries. The children and adults both enjoy having new books to read at bedtime.
