Pastor's Letter

The Finance Council under the direction of Tom Miller met again this week to review the parish finances. While the parish operates on a fiscal year ending on July 1st, these donor statistics are based on a calendar year.

Below is a summary of your generous donations combined from the **Sunday collection and Faith Direct**. This does not include Christmas/Easter, Holy Days, Building Fund, or other special collections throughout the year.

This is a 4.6% increase over 2015. Thank you for your ongoing support. Our parish and its ministries help change peoples lives and are directly supported by these contributions.

The 256 donors who give less than \$25 per year typically attend Mass infrequently. Of the 1,392 donors who give at least \$25 per year, the average contribution per family is \$748.80 per year or \$14.42 per week.

Our parish continues to move closer to becoming a stewardship parish in which we give back in thankful gratitude to God from the gifts he has given us to help create a spiritual balance in our lives of our time, talent and treasure.

I recently watched the film adaptation of "Godspell" with my teenage daughter. I had such fond memories of watching it when I was young, back in the day. I listened to the soundtrack so many times and learned to play many of the songs on my guitar. The exclamation from the show, "You are the light of the world!" has always been firmly planted in my mind.

There will always be people who see the Gospel of Jesus Christ as dated, irrelevant, and even hokey. You and I are called to be the light of the world? Good stewards must never shy away from living lives that truly bear witness to the reality of the Gospel. The parables of Jesus have as much meaning for us today as ever. Look around. 

Saint James School

Dear Parents and Parishioners,

The students at St. James School finished the second round of the **STAR ASSESSMENT** in November, and we have great cause to celebrate!

After the first round of STAR, 69 percent of the SJS students scored at or above the Archdiocesan benchmark in reading, and 87 percent of the students scored at or above the Archdiocesan benchmark in math. After the second round, 77 percent of the SJS students scored at or above the Archdiocesan benchmark in reading, and 90 percent of them scored above the Archdiocesan benchmark in math!

About percentile (%ile) scores

Percentile scores provide a measure of a student's performance as compared to other students in the same grade nationally. For example, a student with a percentile rank score of 50 performed as well as or better than 50 percent of other students in the same grade nationally. Therefore, the 50%ile score is considered to indicate average performance, and many school districts set their benchmark at the 50%ile.

About the Archdiocesan benchmark

Unlike other districts, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles sets its benchmark at the 65%ile, meaning that the goal is for students in our schools to score as well as or better than 65 percent of those who take the test. Research shows that elementary students who score at or above the 65 %ile have a greater chance of success in high school and college.

Further cause for celebration is that SJS students score in the top 5% of all 218 schools in the Archdiocese in both reading and math!!!!

These results point to the outstanding teachers we have, the students who take learning seriously, parents who support our school, our programs, and their children's education and our parishioners who support SJS which enables us to provide a quality Catholic education at SJS.

I give joyful thanks for each of our teachers, staff, students, parents and parishioners.

May God bless all of us as we renew our commitment to help our children achieve growth and reach their potential, both academically and spiritually.
