Catechism Q&A

Q: Our next topic in this series brings us to letter S-Saints! But a quick look at the index of the Catechism Of The Catholic Church lists no entries about sainthood under the topic of Saints. None. Why?

A: The catechism redirects readers looking for Saints to another topic heading where the teachings of the church regarding saints are presented. Go to that heading and you'll find the core of the sanctity, example, significance, and the enduring essence of the Holy Spirit found in every saint. The heading? Holiness.

You can also read Matthew Kelly's *Resisting Happiness*, Chapter 21, called "The Power of Habits", where brief, cogent observations are made about saint-like habits.

Our own St. James 125th Anniversary year history offers many examples of saint-like perseverance by generations of parishioners whose vision and faith helped build our church.

The catechism, under that subject of holiness, touches on how all Christians are called to holiness in Paragraphs 2013-2014: "Thus the holiness of the People of God will grow in fruitful abundance, as is clearly shown in the history of the Church through the lives of so many saints."

"Spiritual progress", the catechism calls it, as we move toward "ever more intimate union with Christ."

Isn't that beautiful?

St. James—Celebrating 125 years



The historical record, and information presented by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles Catholic Directory, shows that the winter season of 1891-1892 saw Bishop Francisco Mora preside over the dedication of our first church, The Dominguez Chapel.

Bishop Mora, in charge of the nearly 76,000 square miles of the Diocese of Monterey-Los Angeles, present at the beginnings of what was to be St. James Church, was nearing the end of his 18 years of service as Bishop, having established 72 parishes and welcomed the first Catholic newspaper for the diocese, The Tidings in 1885.

He resigned in 1896. The History of the Ordinaries of the Archdiocese gives us a brief summary of the successor to the tireless Bishop Mora, a successor whose legacy endures prominently for so many: Bishop Montgomery.

Bishop Montgomery was born in Davis County, Kentucky, the first American-born head of the diocese, ordained in 1879 and consecrated a Bishop in 1894. He assisted in the administration of the diocese as coadjutor, (the term coadjutor describes a bishop assisting a diocesan bishop, often having the right of succession), because of Bishop Mora's now failing health.

He assumed complete administration of the Diocese of Monterey-Los Angeles in 1896. During his seven years as Bishop, he faced serious bigotry, (anti-Catholic sentiment abounded in those days), but proved himself a "great civic leader and dynamic churchman."

In 1903 he was named coadjutor to Archbishop Patrick Riordan of San Francisco. A Bishop Montgomery High School biography reports that during the devastating 1906 San Francisco earthquake, where fires raged over 500 blocks, that it was Bishop Montgomery who led the archdiocese in caring for the victims of this tragedy.

He was immediately looked upon as a symbol of hope in the community. He served as archbishop for four years and died in San Francisco in 1907, "mourned by Catholics and non-Catholics throughout the state."

Everyday Stewardship

In the past year, my wireless provider introduced something called HD Voice.

Suddenly, the voice I heard on my phone was unbelievably clear and it felt at times like both the caller and I were in the same room. The best aspect of this feature is that it didn't cost the customer any additional fees and it didn't require any changes to the phone. I could say it was free, but I suspect I was already paying for it in my monthly bill anyway. At least it felt free.

The clearer the voice calling you, the easier it is to recognize who it is on the other end of the call. How clearly can you hear the voice of Jesus Christ?

In John's Gospel, Jesus speaks of the gatekeeper who opens the gate and calls for his sheep.



They respond because they know his voice. Others try to lure the sheep when the gatekeeper is not there, but the sheep find their voices unclear or unfamiliar.

Jesus is our gatekeeper, but unlike receiving something for free from a wireless company, to be able to hear his voice we need to pay attention and practice listening.

By developing a stewardship way of life that is mindful and prayerful, we become attuned to his voice and are able to discern when the call is from our Lord and when it is from an imposter.

It is great to talk about all the things we can do and all the gifts we can share, but if are not listening for his call to hear where our offerings are needed, we can end up like a lost sheep searching for the gatekeeper.



Gospel Reflection

"Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture." Jesus uses the image of a gate today to help us understand how we are to relate to him. He is our path to "pasture," in other words, to the peace and prosperity that we long for.

He shows us the way to find all that we need right there before us.

Some people, however, may think that it's better to avoid the trouble of finding the gate and thus choose to enter another way instead. But Jesus says, "Whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber."

Although this is all cast in the gentle terms of an analogy about sheep, the message is actually rather stern.

Jesus is telling us that if we don't follow him, we are taking the wrong course of action.

He is not suggesting a kind of relativistic principle that says, "Following me is one of many good options." No.

He is telling us that in order to "have life and have it more abundantly," we must follow the path that goes by way of Christ.

This isn't always the easiest path to follow.

It might mean taking the long way around a situation instead of a shortcut.

It might mean waiting a little while to get to that pasture instead of hopping the fence and finding it on our own terms.

Insisting on using the gate may also make us look like fools to those around us.

But to be truly faithful followers of Jesus, we need to trust that his way is the best way. We need to trust that, by letting him lead, we will ultimately end up in the best possible pasture.

In our culture, it is becoming less and less popular to believe in one true religion, but as Christians we know that Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life.


