Dear Friends and Family,

Last Sunday, Bishop Marc Trudeau of our San Pedro Region of the Archdiocese, celebrated the Noon Mass with us. Our Masses called us to Respect Life and were highlighted by the Rose Procession celebrating the sacredness of life. We thank Linda Houston and her ministry committee for organizing the day and all the participants who brought up the roses at each Mass. The sacredness of life is something that our culture has lost sight of and we, too, need to celebrate and reaffirm our lives and the stewardship of life entrusted to us.

Bishop Marc's visit was to celebrate with us the Blessing and Dedication of our new property. Even though we closed escrow on the property last June, it never felt totally 'ours' until this weekend. What we have often referred to as the 'former South Bay Christian Church' and the 'Korean Church' are no longer. They are now our St. James Community Campus. The buildings still need names, but for now, maybe the 'chapel' and 'formation center' until we get a better sense of how we will best use them.

I have heard some questions about why is St. James 'expanding' our property. It is a term I, too, have used. In reality, while St. James school will remain where it is, we are 'consolidating' the rest of our property and facilities to a unified campus. The Preschool will remain where it is, but everything in the other buildings will eventually be moved to the new property. It is a process that will happen gradually over a number of years and what will happen with the rest of the property on the east side of Pacific Coast Highway will most likely be decided by the next generation.

This gift of being able to consolidate to a unified campus will become over the years, one of the most significant events in the life of St. James. It will take a real generosity of heart from each of us, but what we are doing now is transformative for us and the future of the parish.


Donor Spotlight

The Opportunity

Since its founding in 1910, South Bay Christian Church ministered to Redondo Beach from the property across Vincent Street from St. James. In 2013, with an aging and declining membership of under 30, they decided to disband and deeded the property to their denomination, the Disciples of Christ. In 2019, after unsuccessfully trying to create a national ministry-development center, they decided to sell the property. Bidding against 8 developers who wanted to build condos, the Disciples determined they wanted the facilities to remain for religious purposes and accepted St. James' offer of \$9M. It was a hard decision to make for our Pastoral and Finance Councils because of the high cost, but the needs of our parish and opportunities it gives us was a priority.

Our main concerns are:

- Safety
- Unified campus
- Parking
- Long term future of St. James' needs

The Property

Formation Center: The familiar building we see on the corner of Vincent and Broadway is the old church/hall built in 1940 that South Bay Korean Congregation has rented for the last 21 years. Built in a traditional style of church above, and basement hall below, the building includes 2 classrooms, 2 offices, a large kitchen and conference/dining room, as well as a workroom and storage rooms.

St. James can begin to use the facilities for our Adult RCIA, Confirmation, Baptism and other classes. We plan to move our Sunday School program here where the children are closer to the church and hope to revive our Baby-sitting program here as well.

The Youth Ministry is also looking to create a youth center in the downstairs hall.

Parking Lot: The parking lot is a big addition to St. James giving us an additional 70 parking spaces. The entrance/exit is from Broadway.

Chapel: In 1964, South Bay Christian built a bigger church on the property which holds about 250 people. The nave/sanctuary area is about 1/3 larger than Kavanagh Hall. We still need to assess the best use and configuration of the space as chapel or auditorium. It has a meeting room in the choir loft area as well as a 'sacristy' area behind the altar with a 2nd floor work room with storage and a 3rd floor storage and equipment area.

Offices: On Broadway between the old and new church are two smaller buildings used as the church offices and library. We anticipate these will also be offices for us as we begin to move activities and programs to the site.

Education Building: The final building is an Education Building, also located between the old and new churches. This is a 3-story classroom structure. It was in the process of being renovated as a state-of-the art educational facility for their new 'Hatchery' ministry-development program begun in 2014.

They had difficulty attracting participants and in 2016, after they had completed the demolition part of the project, they decided to delay the renovation and secure the building. It has 4 large classroom/meeting rooms which are designed with moveable partitions to create 8 smaller classrooms. Completion of this building will remain on hold as we focus our attention towards paying the mortgage on the purchase of the property. It will become our Religious Education center which will also be available for other meetings and ministries.
