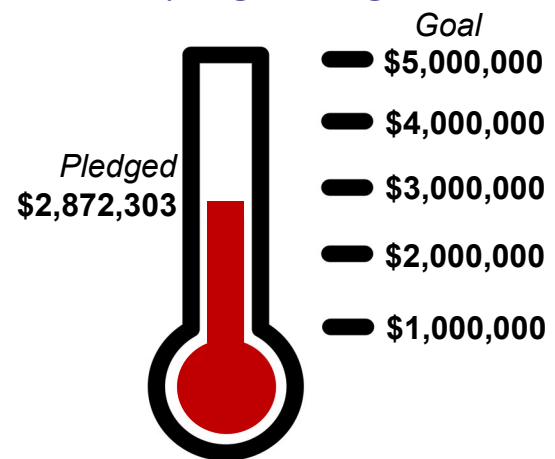

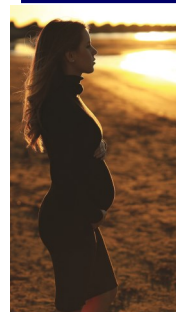
HOW TO PARTICIPATE

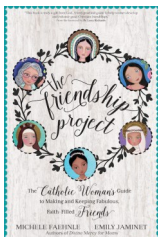

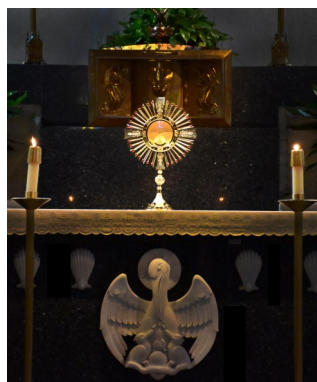

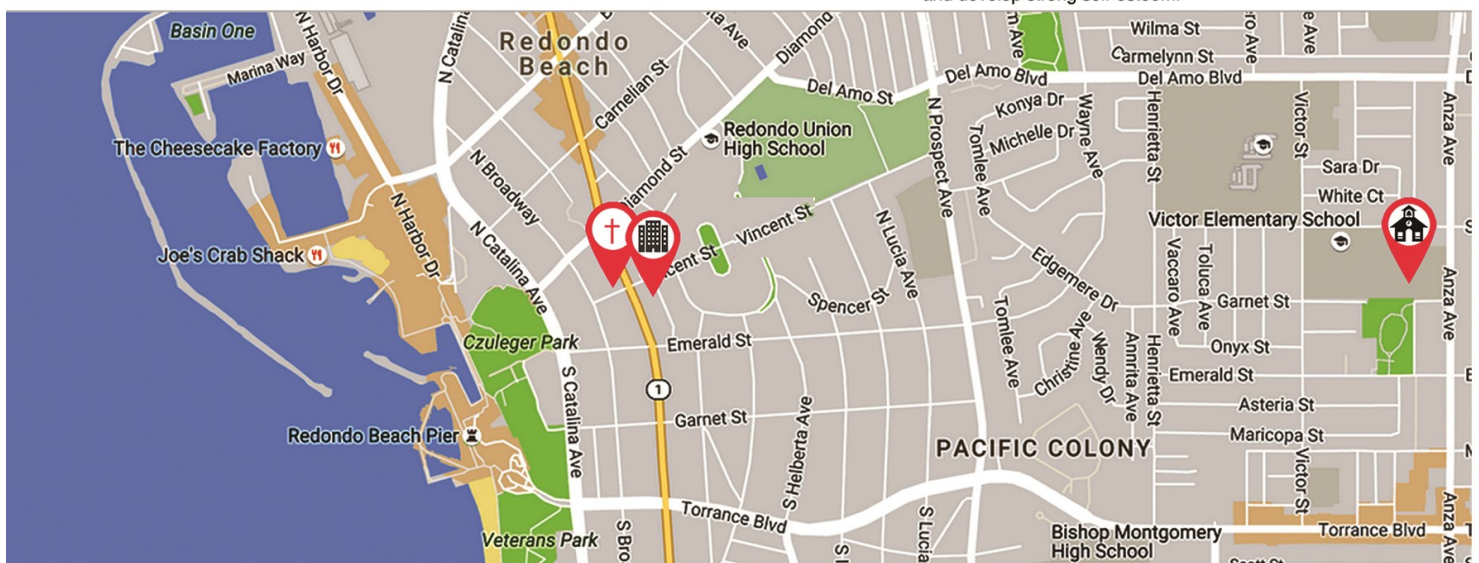
