We joined St. James Parish 46 years ago this spring, married 5 years, with our 3-1/2 year old daughter and 10 month old son.


Over time, we have witnessed many changes and have watched the growth and improvements to our parish and school facilities. We are very grateful to have had St. James be our home for all these years.


