Campaign Pledges Reach \$3.1 Million

Of course, tables and chairs would help, but we do have a 'starter set' to begin with.

Our **Capital Campaign** is speeding up. With many of our parishioners already receiving their campaign mailing with a brochure, a letter from me and pledge card, they are submitting their pledges for this 5-year campaign. During this past week we reached \$3.1 Million in pledges. Thank you so much for those who have responded so generously in the initial outreach of the campaign.
