### Campaign Pledges Reach \$3.1 Million

The Korean Christian community vacated the property on January 31<sup>st</sup>, and with full access to the buildings, it now really is 'St. James'. It is becoming a very exciting time for our parish as our dreams are becoming a reality. We are busy cleaning up and getting ready for our ministries to begin using it. Of course, tables and chairs would help, but we do have a 'starter set' to begin with.

Our **Capital Campaign** is speeding up. With many of our parishioners already receiving their campaign mailing with a brochure, a letter from me and pledge card, they are submitting their pledges for this 5-year campaign. During this past week we reached \$3.1 Million in pledges. Thank you so much for those who have responded so generously in the initial outreach of the campaign.

If you have already received your mailing and have had a chance to consider your own ability to respond to the campaign with your pledge, I would encourage you to do so now so that we can really begin to focus on our goal. 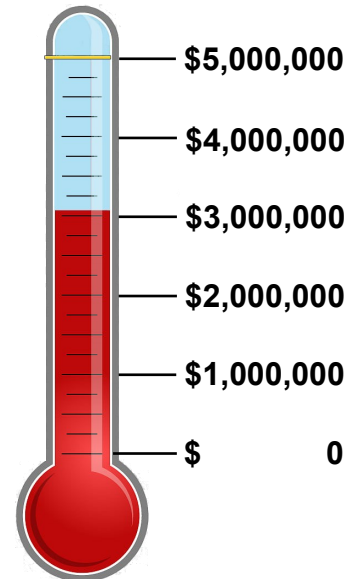
