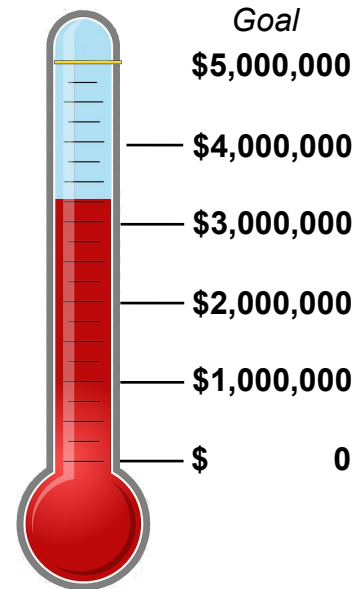

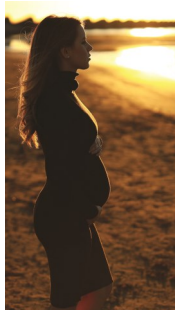


World Down Syndrome Day is March 21

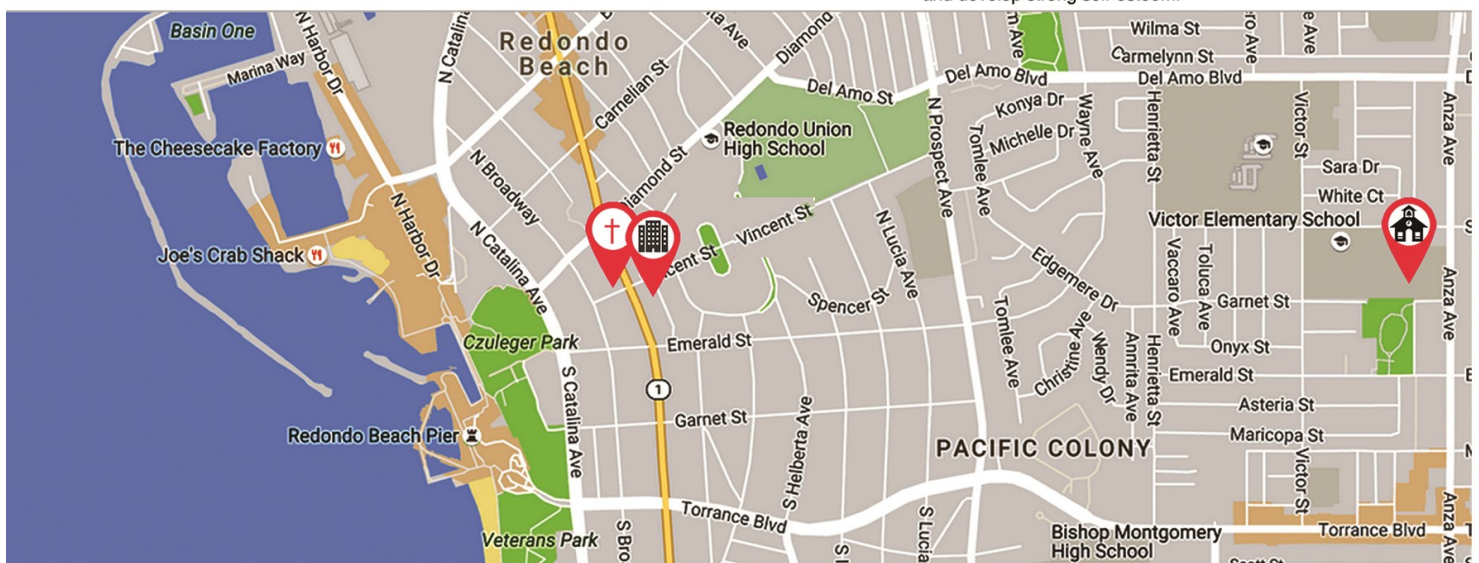
