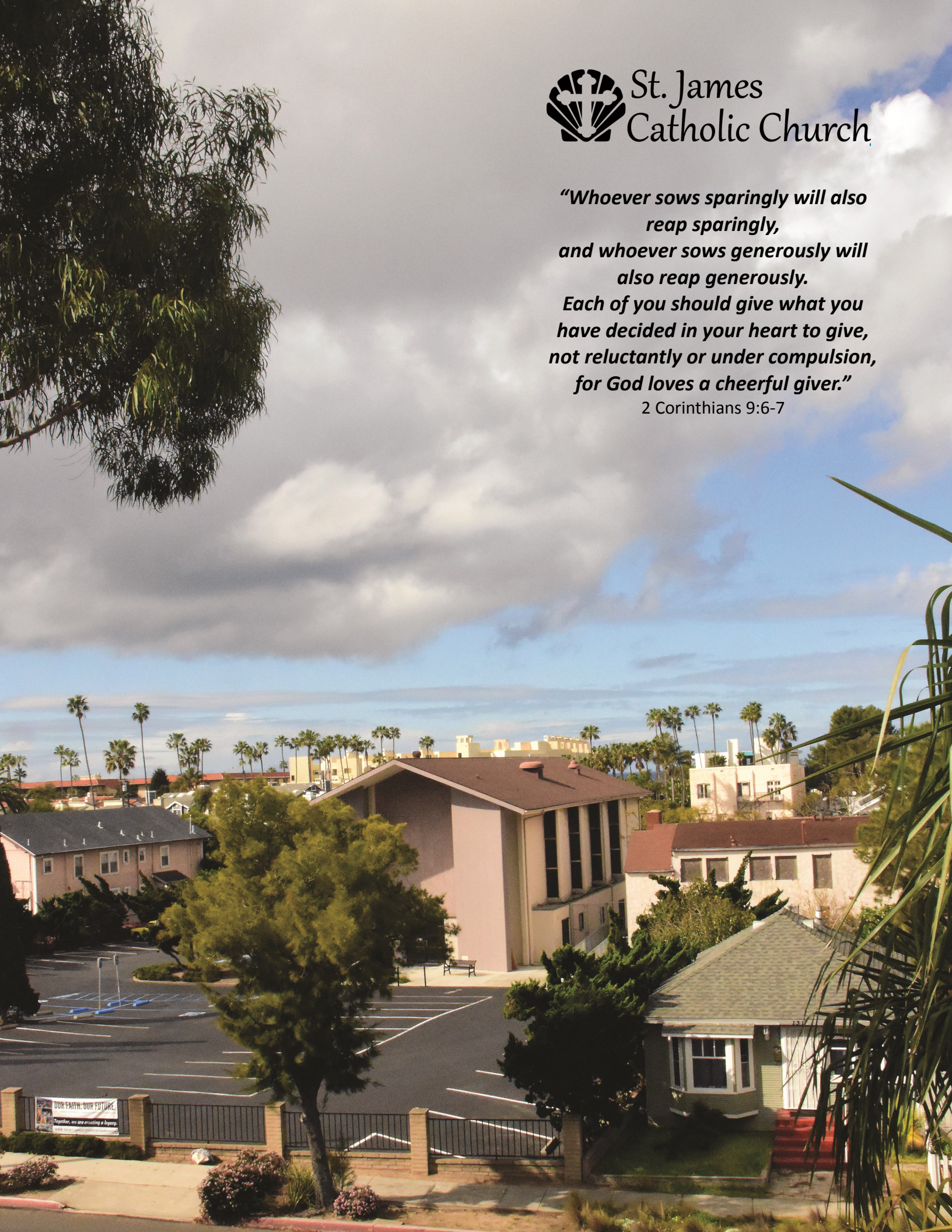

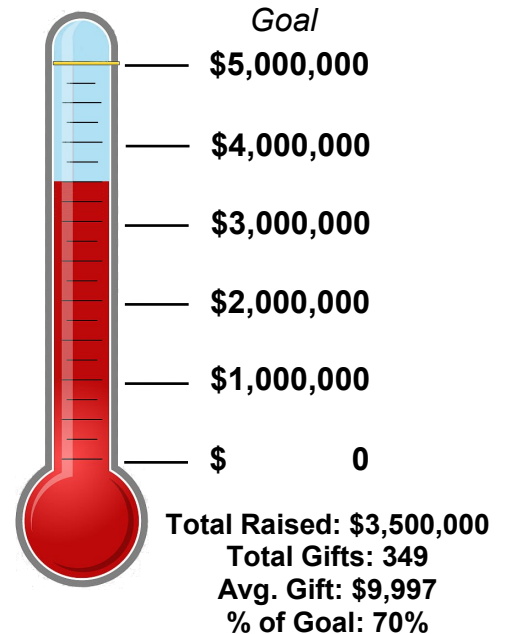

Finally, we might be able convert either the Korean chapel or church to an adoration chapel.

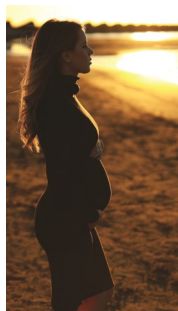


World Down Syndrome Day is March 21

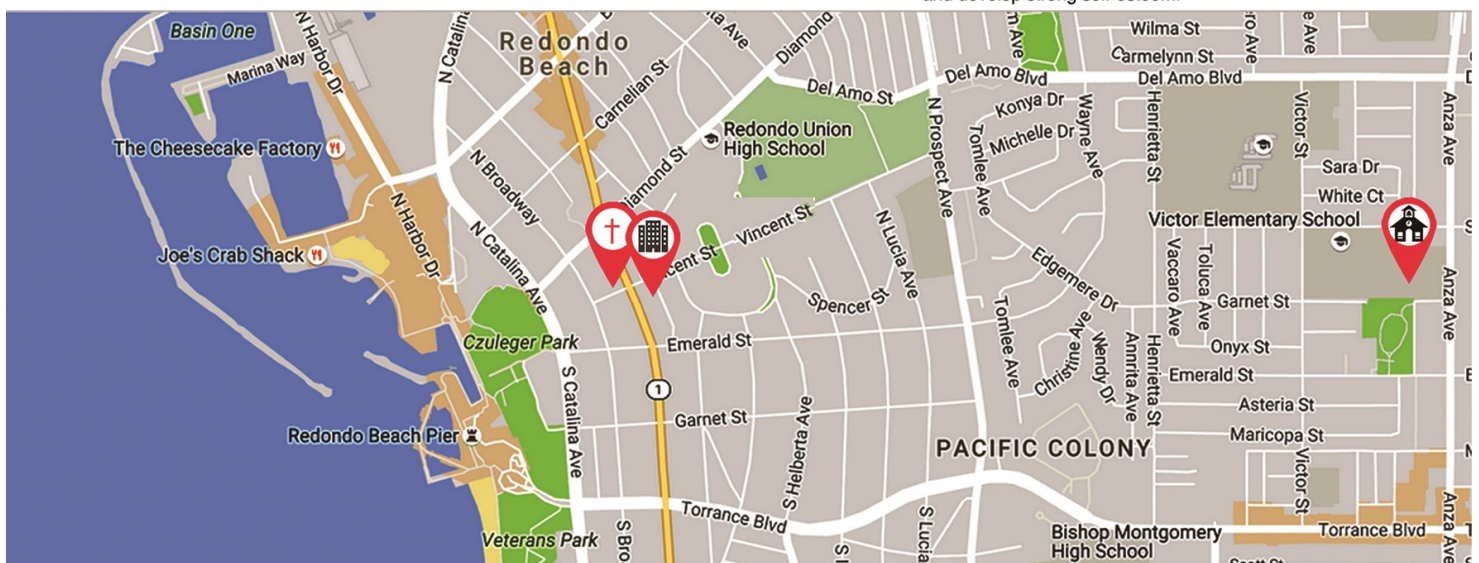
