Dear Friends and Families of St. James.

Palms Blessed Now-Distributed When Safe.

We have been informed by the Archdiocese that out of caution for the safety of everyone, the Palms blessed on Palm Sunday may not be distributed or left out for the faithful to pick up. They will be available later, when it is safe.



During Holy Week and beyond we will be distracted by the increased outbreak of Covid-19. I pray that during these next 4 weeks you and your family will be kept free from the virus.

During this time of isolation it will also be a perfect time to enter into the spirituality and grace of Holy Week. All the Masses of Holy Week will be livestreamed from the Cathedral (see the details in the bulletin.) We will also have our Sunday and daily Masses and Holy Week Liturgies posted on our website, www.SaintJames.Church

As the virus reminds us of our own mortality and frailty, Easter will bring us to the hope and joy of God's great love and healing grace for us. Make the time to pray with us and make your home a sacred space as you pray there, but joined with us all as a church of faith at St. James. Open your heart and soul to the saving love of Christ for you.

I have begun calling parishioners on the phone to see how you are doing and making sure your needs are being met. Of course, I can't call everyone in a parish this size, but a whole team of parishioners have volunteered to help me. We hope you will accept our calls or call us back as it helps us all stay connected as the family we are at St. James. We will only be checking in with you. (In this time of heightened scams, be careful, others will try to con you, even saying they are from the church.)

Finally, please see the bulletin article about continuing your financial support of the parish as best you can during the pandemic. The Finance Council is making every effort to help us cut back on all our expenses, but 4 months of limited income will be a huge challenge.

May the Lord continue to bless and protect you all.

How to make a Spiritual Communion when no public Mass is available

For various reasons we may be prevented from receiving the Eucharist at Mass. At these times the Church calls us to make an act of "spiritual communion," where we unite ourselves to God through prayer. It is a beautiful way to express to God our desire to be united with him when we are unable to complete that union in the reception of Holy Communion.

As Public Masses are banned throughout the country, literally thousands of Masses are celebrated each day and, in addition to watching them on television or computer screens, the faithful can receive "spiritual Communion."

Pope Francis, after reciting a live-streamed Angelus prayer March 15, told people, "United to Christ we are never alone, but instead form one body, of which He is the head. It is a union that is nourished with prayer and also with spiritual communion in the Eucharist, a practice that is recommended when it isn't possible to receive the sacrament."

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

Catholics are encouraged to continue to pray at home with their families and join to the sacrifice of the Mass by making an act of spiritual communion. We are also encouraged to participate in the Holy Mass via the Internet or television. The Archdiocese will provide a livestream of non-public Masses celebrated by the priests from the Cathedral of Our Lady of Angels daily.

- **St. Jean-Marie Vianney** said, "If we are deprived of Sacramental Communion, let us replace it, as far as we can, by spiritual communion, which we can make every moment; for we ought to have always a burning desire to receive the good God".
- **St. Thomas Aquinas** described Spiritual Communion as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Holy Sacrament and a loving embrace as though we had already received Him."
- **St. Teresa of Jesus** wrote, "When you do not receive communion and you do not attend Mass, you can make a spiritual communion, which is a most beneficial practice, by it the love of God will be greatly impressed on you."

The Newest Liturgical Guidelines and **How They Affect St. James**

The Archbishop in consultation with the Auxiliary Bishops and the Council of Priests have established liturgical accommodations in response to keeping everyone safe. These guidelines will remain in effect during the pandemic crisis.

CHURCHES

Parish churches are closed to the public until April 19, 2020 or until further notice.

Church offices closed to the public. Parish staff members will answer telephones and answer emails.

MASS

The public celebration of Mass has been suspended in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles until April 19th, or until further notice.

The priests at St. James will celebrate daily Mass for the intentions of the parish each day. These Masses can be viewed on the parish website: www.SaintJames.church

The Mass from the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angles may also be viewed via livestream. The weekday and Sunday Mass will be livestreamed via the LA Catholics Facebook page (facebook.com/ lacatholics). For more information on additional Mass broadcasts on TV and radio, visit: lacatholics.org/emergency. We are reminded to keep the Lord's Day holy.

Some ways to do this include: reading the Gospels, praying with your families, and to joining yourself to the sacrifice of the Mass by making an act of spiritual communion.

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSION

All regularly scheduled confession times are cancelled.

Pope Francis reminded us in his homily on March 20. 2020, the faithful who are physically unable to attend individual Reconciliation of the Church's teaching on Perfect Contrition. Such contrition arises when the penitent expresses a love of God above all else, the sincere desire for forgiveness, and firm resolution to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation as soon as possible when available. Perfect contrition obtains the forgiveness of sins, both venial and mortal. (cf. Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) 1452) Priests may offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation only in danger of death or extremely extraordinary situations.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Priests will continue to attend to the needs of those who ask for the Anointing of the Sick.

For the safety of the homebound, sick calls and distribution of Holy Communion are reserved to priests and only in serious need.

BAPTISM

Unless an emergency, the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism is to be postponed.

WEDDINGS

All Weddings until April 19, 2020 or until further notice, are to be postponed.

FUNERALS

Funerals may take place only in the form of "The Rite of Committal with Final Commendation" (also known as the "Graveside Service").

A memorial Mass can be scheduled appropriately at a later date.

CONFIRMATIONS AND FIRST COMMUNIONS

Confirmation at St. James is scheduled for Saturday. May 16th and so is not currently postponed.

First Communions at St. James are scheduled for Saturday, May 9th, and are not currently postponed.

HOLY WEEK

Holy Week Liturgies at St. James

(Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday) will be celebrated privately for the parish by the priests and the video posted on our website: www.SaintJames.church

Easter Vigil baptisms have been postponed.
