Pastor's Letter

Dear Friends and Families of St. James,

We thank Fr. Rudy for being with us last weekend and sharing the important work that is being done in his parish to minister to the spiritual and temporal needs of his parish in Mexico. To support his ministry you may still simply write your check to: St. James and in the memo line put: "Mission Appeal" and we will send one check from the parish to the Mission Office for Fr. Rudy's work.

This week Archbishop Gomez has called all of the incardinated priests of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles to join him for a Convocation, 4 days of reflection, discussions and fellowship. Fr. Jim and I will be joining Archbishop Gomez with about 300 other priests of the Archdiocese from Monday thru Thursday this week.

An 'incardinated' priest is one whose 'official bishop' is the bishop of Los Angeles. Fr. Jim and I are incardinated priests of Los Angeles. Fr. Thaddeus belongs to a religious community, the Sons of Mary, Mother of Mercy, SMMM. and Fr. Paul is a diocesan priest but is incardinated in the Diocese of Damongo in Ghana and the bishop of Damongo is his superior.

Fr. Thaddeus and Fr. Paul will be celebrating the daily Masses and taking care of the spiritual and organizational needs of St. James while we are away.

The last time we were together with Archbishop Gomez united as the priests of the Archdiocese was 3 years ago, in 2019. Since then, Covid has isolated us from each other and our parishes have struggled. Each of us have committed our whole lives to the building up of the Church in Los Angeles and obedience to the Archbishop. These days are so important for us as our own parish ministries often keep us apart. We are not priests of individual parishes. We are priests of the Archdiocese, each called in various ministries, but united always in one brotherhood of priests in service to the entire Faithful of Los Angeles under the guidance of the Archbishop.

Your prayers and support of the Convocation for the good of the archbishop, the clergy and all of our parishes and ministries are so appreciated.

6. WRAP IT UP! THANK GOD FOR THE TIME TO BE WITH HIM.



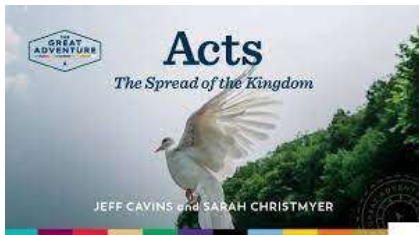

This weeks Topic: "Saints- See Holiness"

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, in a discussion about holiness sets a high bar of faith in Paragraph 2013:

"All are called to holiness...be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect."

This particular goal-setting instruction of the Church about individuals striving for perfection comes to mind this month when the Feast Day of St. Clare is marked. A contemporary and friend of St. Francis, Clare, the Abbess, was described among the lives of the Saints as barefoot, dressed in sack-cloth and noble in her perfect poverty.

In contrast to the secular luxuries of the 11th century, Clare experienced assaults on her faith in many forms, including infidels advancing against the convent. In the face of these trials, Clare, part of a long line of strong, saintly, exemplary women, continued to answer that call to holiness.

As we come together at Mass, speaking in unison during the Apostle's Creed about a belief in the communion of Saints, the *Catechism* reminds us that by their intercession, the saints.

"...fix the whole Church more firmly in holiness."

That helps.

In the winter of 2002, Pope St. John Paul II spoke about the saints and their guiding example regarding which way we should go in order to move along the path toward greater holiness:

"St. Clare and countless other Christian saints and martyrs were marked by the mystery of the cross. Their secret was precisely this sign of the triumph of love over hatred, of forgiveness over retaliation, of good over evil. We are called to go forward in their footsteps."

The Cross. Love. Forgiveness. Good over evil; just some of the directional markers along the road to holiness. The St. James Choir musically honors all saintly archetypes of faithful perseverance who move toward perfection:

"All you holy men and women, pray for us."

The serious disciple knows the necessity and value of discipline.

Thinking of discipline as something punitive in nature, we underscore its place in our spiritual lives. Discipline is really about a radical trust in God and his guidance.

"When you are conducted by a guide who takes you through an unknown country at night across fields where there are no tracks, by his own skill, asking no advice from anyone, giving no inkling of his plans, what choice do you have but to give yourself completely to his guidance? If you are convinced that he is a good guide, you must have faith in him and abandon yourself to his care (Jean-Pierre de Caussade)."

If someone wants to be physically fit, they readily find a competent trainer who sets them on a rigorous schedule. Determined to reach their goals, they sacrifice personal pleasure and trust in his guidance. Why should it be any different with God?

In order to remain true to the way Jesus places before us, we have to listen, learn, and be willing to change. Falling in love with God and maintaining that relationship requires an investment of time, energy, and hard work. Putting personal preferences aside in pursuit of the Gospel and giving proper attention to our spiritual lives is challenging work. At first, "all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it (Hebrews)."

"What God does is essentially good. It does not need to be reformed or controlled... If you would live according to the Gospels, give yourself completely and simply to the action of God." - (Jean-Pierre de Caussade)

Submission to the holy will of God is not a submission to a set of pre-ordained set of circumstances. Rather, it is an abandonment and trust in God's creative, life-giving, and salvific power. God brings light out of darkness and life out of death. Nurturing this bond of trust and seeking God in all things creates an intimate and particular relationship and bond between our Creator and us. When He comes, there will be no issue with us recognizing Him or Him recognizing us. We will have met before. ©LPI

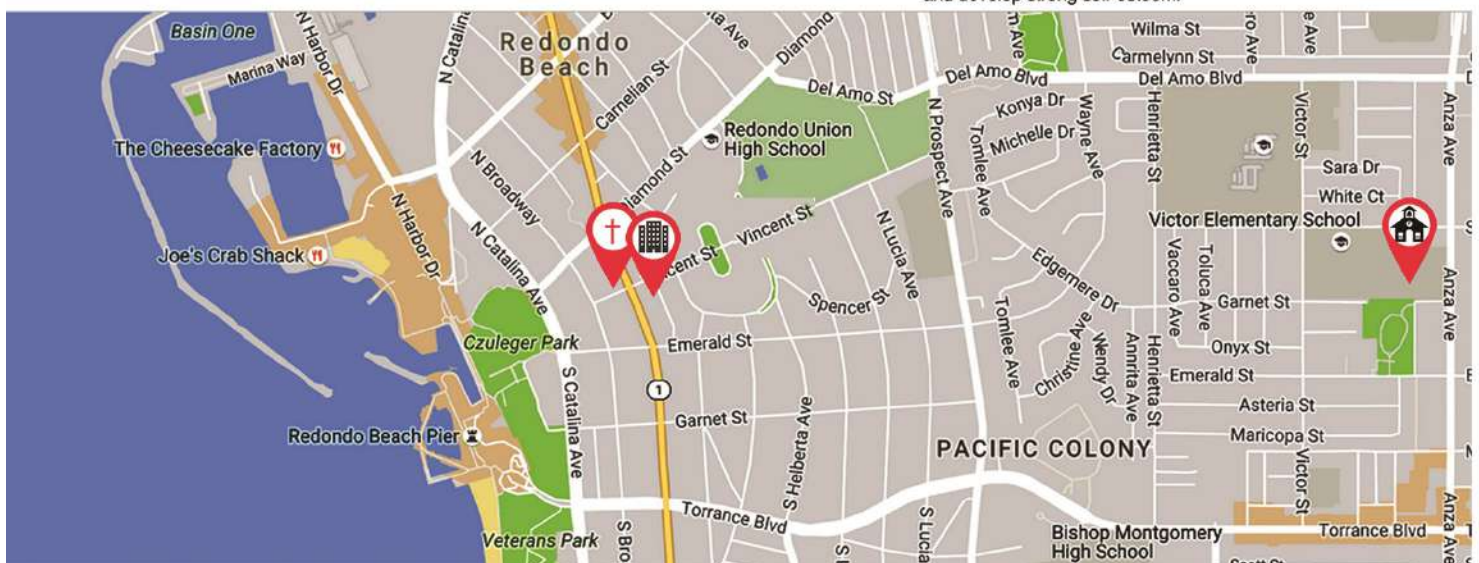
