## Pastor's Letter

Dear Friends and Families of St. James,

For the last 3 years the State of California has set aside the statute of limitations for the filing of past childhood sexual abuse cases (AB218). The filing time finished on December 31<sup>st</sup> and in Los Angeles we are seeing in the news reports of the kinds of cases being filed: private schools, film industry, juvenile halls and camps, amateur to professional sports programs, the Catholic Church, other churches and many other programs. It is a sad commentary on our society and our world.

Unfortunately, many new cases are being filed against the church and we will be hearing about them in the coming weeks and months. They are almost exclusively against priests who have been previously removed from ministry and many of them are already dead. There have been very few cases of abuse reported in the last 20 years.

Since 2002, and before, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles has implemented a wide range of programs for the protection of children.

- An independent review board that investigates any allegation of misconduct or abuse with minors or adults.
- A victim's assistance ministry reaches out to support and assist anyone who comes forward with an allegation.
- The Office of Safeguard the Children provides ongoing support, education, training and resources to help prevent child sexual abuse and to address children's safety in our parishes, school, homes and communities.
- Strict policies and procedures for interacting with minors are in place.
- All clergy, paid parish/school personnel and volunteers who work regularly in a supervisory role with children or youth must be fingerprinted.
- Every adult involved in any ministry or service where children may be present must be 'Virtus<sup>®</sup>' certified every 4 years—a program of education and awareness that all in ministry are equipped to be constantly vigilant in protecting our children and many of them are also fingerprinted.
- All of our children in Catholic schools and our Religious Education programs (about 170,000 per year) participate annually in awareness and safeguarding programs.
- Healing Gardens for victims of sexual abuse are being built in each of our Pastoral Regions.

Our ongoing efforts are working to safeguard our children. We are saddened by those who were betrayed and hurt in the past and we pray for healing for all victims of abuse in our society.

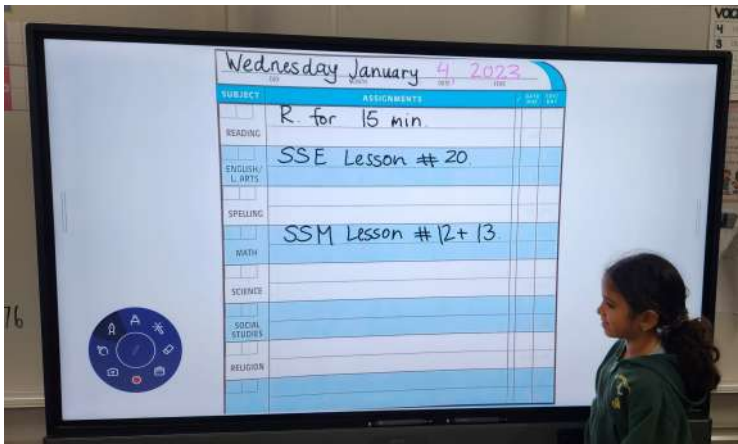

**Virtue - Practice Makes Progress**

This year's seasonal St. James Catholic Church mailer featured Christmas Mass times, calling on the faithful to, "Behold The Christ Child." Included was a wonderful "Welcome Home!" invitation card: "Come and see how much Jesus loves you."

It certainly holds that like the *Holy Moments* which author Matthew Kelly presents in his book, that we also find within our Church an abundance of holy moments within the liturgy and as part of the solemnity and celebration of the birth of a savior. Fittingly, the mailer included the culminating resolution of Luke 2:30, "My eyes have seen your salvation."

The Christmas mailer ends with:

*"Let those who visit here be blessed with joy, love, and peace."*

**Q:** What does the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* say about the virtuousness of these blessings?

**A:** CCC #1804: "Human virtues make possible...joy in leading a morally good life...the virtuous practices the good."

CCC#1822: "Love is the theological virtue by which we love God above all things..."

CCC#2305: "Earthly peace is the image and fruit of the peace of Christ..."

Mother Teresa touched on these three virtues in her own directly insightful, welcoming, inclusive way:

"In the end it's very simple. Smile five times a day...Do it for peace...spread love and joy..."

A friend of mine is a young priest who teaches high school physics at a Catholic boys' prep school. Like many today, the boys often think science and religion are enemies. So, he delights in their raised eyebrows when he reminds them his first full-time job as a priest was to be an astrophysicist. He cataloged the size, shape, and matter of distant stars. He tells them, "Science gave me more love for God, not less."

The Magi were something like scientist-astronomers. Like today's scientists, they employed disciplined methods of discovering dependable patterns in the world. Their rigorous commitment to the truth led them to the joy of discovering Jesus. Their love for knowledge leads them to worship the Source of all knowledge. Luke says of them, "**They were overjoyed at seeing the star.**"

We may see the universe as cold and empty and feel sad. But why should we do that? The Magi, like my priest-friend, show us there is another way to experience the world. We use our intelligence to discover the beautiful patterns in the world — in mathematics, physics, astronomy, biology, neuroscience, and so on — and allow this to lead us to greater love for God. So, my fellow Magi: the world needs us to be overjoyed at finding God in science and, finally and fully, in Jesus.

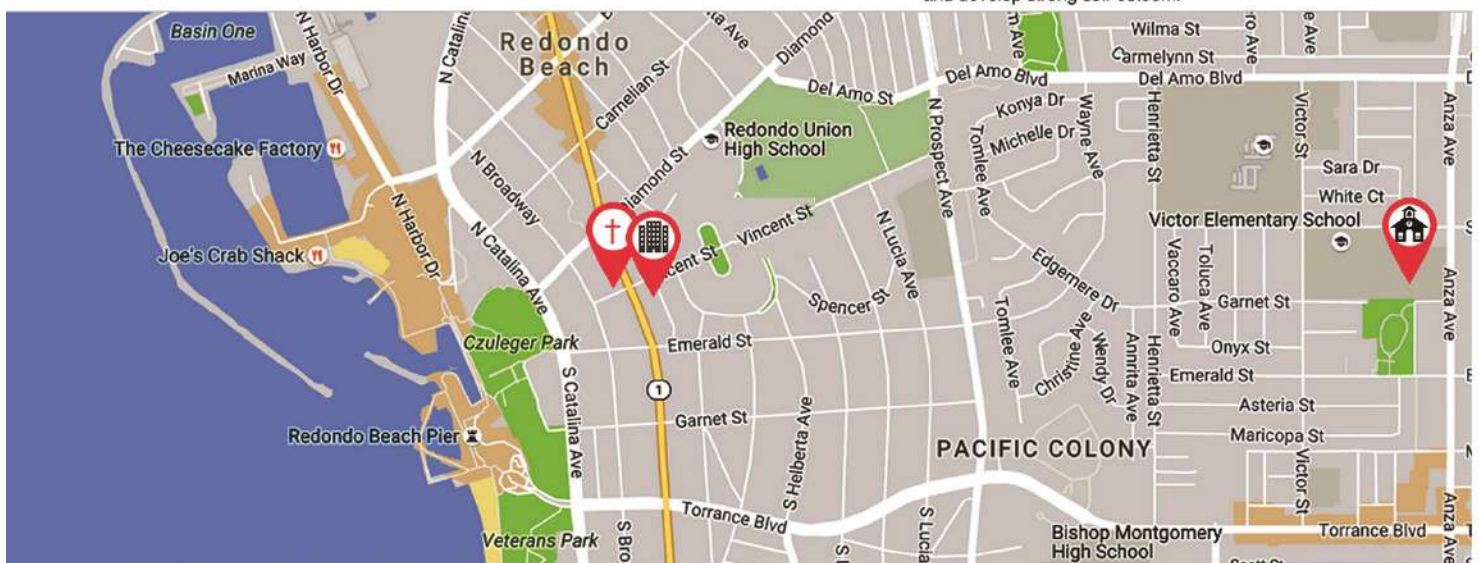
