He is so approachable with an easy smile that supports his strong faith and close relationship with the Lord. For those who have had an opportunity to talk to him or spend some time with him, he becomes like a long-time friend so quickly.

**Fr. Paul will be at the Masses on January 28<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>** and outside the church after all the Masses so that you might have an opportunity to greet him and wish him well as he returns to a new assignment in his diocese.

In addition to being the Vocation Director for the diocese, he will be an Associate Pastor in a parish and tasked with developing a shrine area into a Prayer Center for the diocese.

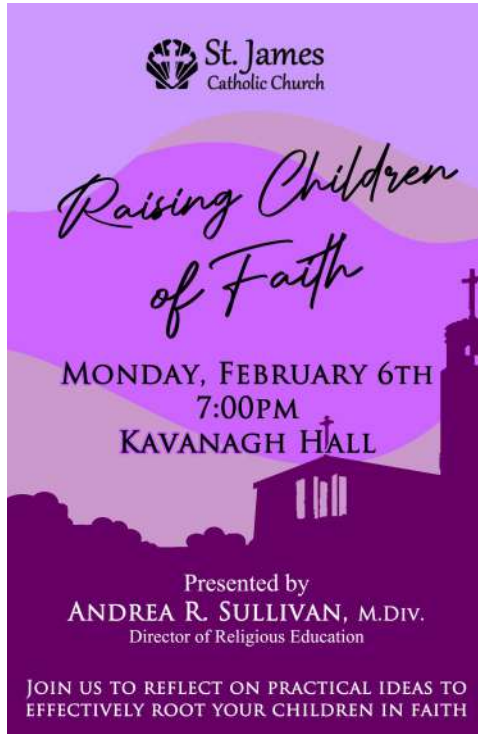

## Powerful Moments Of Holy Hope

In the summer of the year 386 a man was experiencing a personal crisis.

He was frustrated and dissatisfied by what he felt was the routine nature of this point in his life; a life he felt was a disheartening, bewildering "mess".

One of his biographers writes that the man's career was not taking off as he had hoped. He was weary of the day to day routine, the grind of just working to make a living; "tired of the rat race." He wondered when he would be able to "ponder the higher ideals of truth, certainty, happiness, the providential order of the world, the principles of evil, the nature of the soul, God"... and...hope.

**Q:** Who is this man who was about to make a positive, more fulfilling turn in a life marked by holy moments ahead?

**A:** That man is Aurelius Augustinus, influential theologian, philosopher, psychologist, Bishop of Hippo, Doctor of the Church, better known as St. Augustine. His monumental contributions to church theology and philosophy explore foundational tenets of Catholicism that are insightful, inspirational, and enduring. St. Augustine also provides, (as all the saints do), a timeless window into humanity and hope.

Matthew Kelly writes in his book *Holy Moments* that, "The world is a mess" In spite of the mess, whether in the 4th Century or the 21st Century, the saints and Matthew Kelly are real-life and literary exponents of hope. Kelly, in writing about hope and holy moments, says: "Holy moments remind us that the future can be better than the past. Holy moments empower us to give others the gift of hope..."

*The Catechism* presents sainthood in its discussion on holiness. Among many citations about hope and holiness, *The Catechism* refers to Matthew 10: "In every circumstance, each one of us should hope, with the grace of God, to persevere to the end."

In a roller coaster of a life that led to conversion and sainthood, St. Augustine, in his additional role as exemplar to the faithful, came to realize those real-life holy moments as he found that necessary measure of hope. He, by his humanity, and by divine providence, persevered to the end, to his and to our benefit.

When I was a young seminarian, I asked a wise old priest how to pray better.

He said simply, "Don't lie when you pray."

He helped me to see how much energy I waste in trying to appear acceptable to God when I pray. For me, prayer was showing off for God and hiding what was ugly.

It's stunning that the Gospel of Matthew tells us of Jesus, "**He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulon and Naphtali...**"

This isn't just the Lord's relocation up north.

It's his moving into places of shame and defeat.

This region was where the enemy invasion of Israel began centuries before. Jesus left the comfortable confines of Nazareth and sought out a place of darkness, not to bring shame, but to announce the dawning of his light.

When we pray, we usually prefer Jesus to stay put in our little Nazareths — where we feel comfortable, successful, and in control.

But he moves. He re-locates into the Zebulons and Naphtalis of our shame, embarrassment, fear, and sense of being defeated.

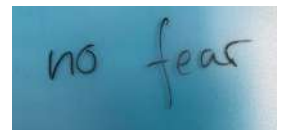
The question for us is: will we allow him to take up residence in *those* places in our prayer time?

Will we talk to him honestly about our places of darkness?

If we do, we're no longer lying when we pray.

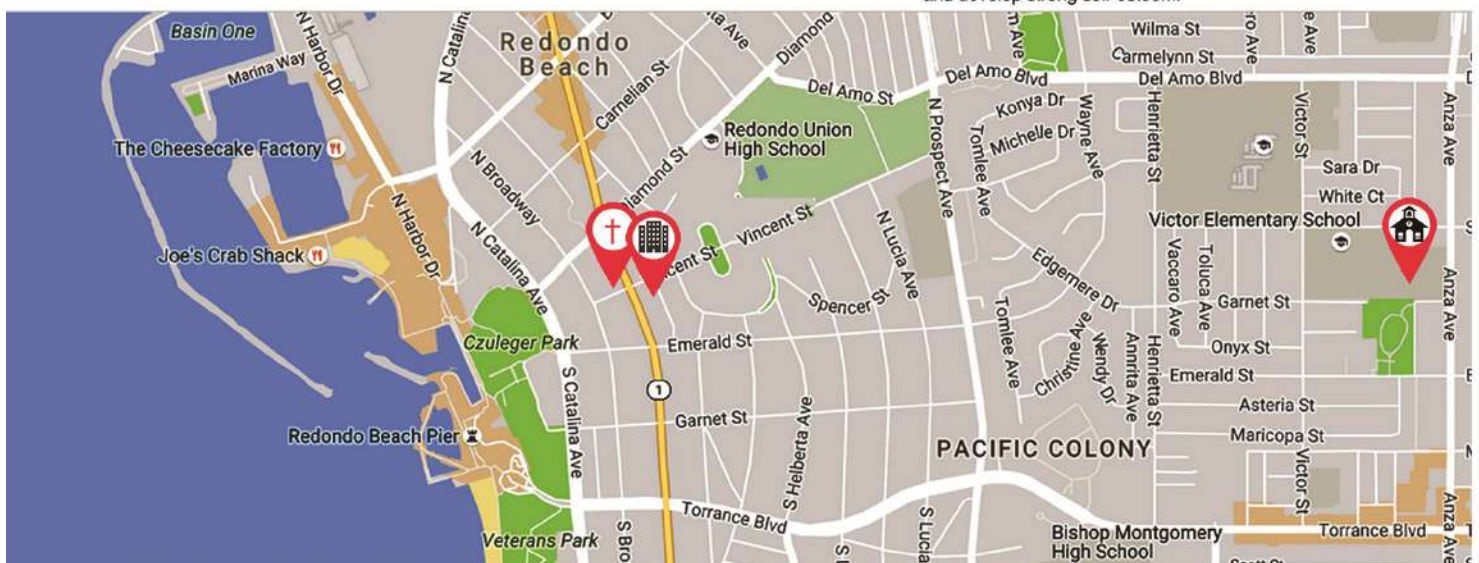
