Dear Friends and Families of St. James

Together In Mission

Here in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles there are about sixty parishes that struggle to survive, and a few more schools in the same situation. Many of them are in the poorest areas of the Archdiocese. The people are filled with faith, but their pockets are empty, and their neighborhoods are rough and dangerous. When our priests gather, I hear stories of the struggles they have and the needs that are present. The anxiety, fear and confusion that surrounds their communities can only be changed with the hope of the Gospel and the power of Christ to overcome.

Together in Mission makes sure that these parishes and schools are able to be the voice of Christ and the heart of his love. They bring the real hope that comes from Christ. This weekend all of us are asked to stand together to provide for the basic needs of these parishes.

Our goal at St. James for *Together in Mission* is \$112,000. We could say that all we need are 112 people to give \$1,000, but that's not going to happen. Some will give that, and others will give more, but the reality is that we must all give something, and give generously. Envelopes are in the pews. Please seriously consider in what way you can make a pledge for an amount you will be able to give during the next six months. If you have not given before, start with something modest, but starting is important, and your help will make a difference in the lives of so many. 


Stations of the Cross



Catholic Q&A Topic: Living Water

The Catechism contains many entries about what the Church believes and teaches regarding the blessings of sacramental grace:

"The sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, by which divine life is dispensed to us."

Q: Which sacrament is it that the Catechism calls
"...the basis of the whole Christian life,
the gateway to life in the spirit...";
the sacrament that the United States Conference of
Catholic Bishops describes as
"Christ's call to holiness."

A: The Bishops give us the answer:

"In *Baptism*, the Holy Spirit moves us to answer God's call to holiness."

Catechism #1214 is one of many citations on this subject:

"To baptize (Greek *baptizein*) means to plunge or immerse..."

St. Gregory elegantly describes that holy act of immersion:

"Baptism is God's most beautiful and magnificent gift...we call it gift, grace, anointing, enlightenment, garment of immortality, bath of rebirth, seal, and most precious gift."

Pope Francis advises:

"Celebrate the date of your baptism every year in your heart. Do it. It is also a duty of justice to the Lord who has been so good to us."

Gospel Meditation

Of all the things Jesus says which seem totally bat-crazy, this one might take the cake:

"But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you."

An enemy is someone who desires the destruction of you, your projects, or those you care about. To love and pray for them is to want their health, strength, and flourishing. But if they thrive, they are more likely to hurt you and others. So, aren't you indirectly willing your own destruction, or that of your friends? If you doubt that this problem is embedded in this teaching, when was the last time you actually prayed honestly for the people you really hate?

How can we solve this riddle so we might actually live this command? Recall that enemy-love is the surest sign that you love someone with God's love, and not with indirect egotism. After all, if my love for my enemy ends up hurting me or my loved ones, it can't be for me. Enemy-love costs more because there are no tit-for-tats. No reciprocity — just loved poured out, and often pain in return. That's why it is so precious and rare. "What is unusual about that?" asks the Lord about love for our friends. Jesus wants us to experience the unusual love which only comes from him.

When Jesus was being killed on the cross, he was loving his executioners. In fact, he was holding them in being as they nailed him to the cross. He loved those who were spiritually piercing his Mother's heart, while they were doing it. And when he rose from the dead, he showed us that this kind of love is always worth it. It's stronger than death. Real love is unusual.
