Pastor's Letter

Archbishop Gomez at St. James for Confirmation

This past Friday evening Archbishop Gomez was at St. James for the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation for 75 of our high school youth and 5 adults. The Archbishop was last here for the celebration of our 125th anniversary as a parish in 2017.

Our youth, along with the faithful Confirmation Team under the direction of Gretchen Nobleza, have been very dedicated during the last 2 years of preparation participating in the study nights as well as retreats, prayer services, youth conferences and a long list of service projects.

In addition to our adult team of leaders, 49 of our students who were Confirmed during the last 2 years continued in leadership roles as Teen Disciples. This year 55 youth who were confirmed on Friday intend to continue in leadership roles of our youth ministry program as Teen Disciples!

We are very proud of these youth and the exceptional way they have grown in faith and discipleship in the program. Pictures from the Archbishop's visit and the Confirmation are available on the Youth Ministry page, our parish website and our Facebook.



Catholic Q & A

Topic: Mercy

In Shakespeare's comedic play *The Merchant of Venice*, a debt was owed. Portia begs Shylock to show mercy to Antonio. The play's lines in a particular speech about mercy are not only enduringly familiar by their sheer poetic beauty, but are also said to epitomize, "an attribute to God himself:"

"The quality of mercy is not strain'd. It droppeth as the gentle rain from heaven, Upon the place beneath. It is twice blest; It blesseth him that gives, and him that takes..."

Q: What is the Church's "take" on Mercy?

A: The graces and virtue of mercy can be found throughout sacred scripture, the liturgy, sacred tradition, the sacraments, the *Catechism*, and in our prayers. Pope Francis, spoke at Angelus on the realms of forgiveness and "the true justice of God:"

"It is a justice that comes from love, from the depths of compassion and mercy that are the very heart of God…"

At a Papal audience in March, we were reminded that the fifth Beatitude says:

"Blessed are the merciful for they shall obtain mercy..."

The Pope reminds us that in the Lord's Prayer we pray:

"forgive us...as we forgive..."

The Catechism essentially summarizes:

"The works of mercy are charitable actions..." "...works of justice, pleasing to God."

The St. James Choir often sings hymns with themes of



mercy such as "O God Beyond all Praising":

"For we can only wonder at every gift you send. At blessings without number and mercies without end."

God's quality of mercy.

Falling as a gentle rain from heaven.

Gospel Meditation

Traditionally, the four writers of the Gospels are symbolized by four creatures that make their way into Church art and architecture: Matthew, an angel; Mark, a lion; Luke, an ox; and John, an eagle. These images can be found in churches across the world, a nod to those who recorded the stories of Jesus for us, thousands of years ago.

Today's Gospel was written by John. There are a few reasons why John is symbolized by an eagle, but my favorite explanation is that his writings soar like an eagle into the sky with their beautiful, poetic language. The prayer we hear today is no different — Jesus invokes God in a long discourse that might seem mystifying at times, the same way that a poem can be perplexing to understand when we are unfamiliar with the pacing or format.

Consider holding onto the shortest sentence in this prayer: "I pray for them."

Jesus prays for us. For me. For you.

Let that sink deep into your being.

Jesus is on your side. He is aware of what you are holding at this moment. He is aware of your pain, your faith, your mission. And He's rooting for you. This prayer was recorded thousands of years ago, far before you were born. Since before you were born, you were held in prayer. With that certainty, we live. — *Father John Muir*


