

On Wednesday, July 5th, from Noon to 2:30pm, we invite the families of Saint James Parish to our summertime Family Day of Service!


The families that gathered for our Lenten Family Day of Service this spring enjoyed helping the Feed the Needy Program so much that they asked us to bring it back for the summer.

Topic: Sing Out!

Q: How do the faithful today look across the centuries and respond to letters written in the 50s of the first century?

A: They sing.

Last Sunday, Monsignor Mike referenced the greetings that St. Paul, among the chapters of his epistle letters, sent to the Ephesian community in Asia Minor.

There is also a joyful spirit in Paul's letter to the Ephesians, the one in which he encourages them to sing out:

"Be filled with the Holy Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and playing to the Lord in your hearts, giving thanks always and for everything..."

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops reminds us that this majestic Pauline letter about the church deals not so much with that ancient congregation in the city of Ephesus, but that the greater focus is about a church that will make God's plan of salvation known worldwide, in an enduring, universal sense.

Speaking of coming before God with singing, it can be noted that the St. James Choir features wonderful levels of musical and spiritual harmony.

Harmony is defined in a glossary of musical terms as "the combining of tones into chords." The tones of song and faith do indeed reflect the chords that St. Paul outlined all those centuries ago.

The mystically marvelous chords of a song that combine to make beautiful music of thanks and praise may have spiritual parallels within every Catholic heart that strives to live out their own chords of Christianity - personally, and as part of an enriched ecclesial, liturgical community.

The Catechism calls music, "the Church's treasure."

Another term of music is the word *polyphony*, meaning several melodies, each moving independently of the other but producing a harmonious effect.

These component chords of faith also reflect the transformative tones of the kind of music that we sing at Mass and which we carry within us along our faith journey.

May our individual and combined melodies continue to reflect the kind of faith that sings to the Lord from the heart.

Let your song be sung.

Sing out!

In the backyard of the house where I live with other priests, there is a lemon tree which produces a huge amount of fruit.

One evening in the spring I needed some lemons for a chicken dish. I glanced from the kitchen and saw the tree bursting with large, bright, gorgeous lemons, hanging thick on seemingly every branch.

Turning to Fr. Bob (I'll change his name to protect the innocent) who sat on the couch, I said, "Father, could you pick a few lemons for me?"

He said sure and into the backyard he went. He returned a few minutes later empty-handed. "John, there's no lemons. Sorry."

I said, "What are you talking about?" I looked again and saw the grapefruit tree on the other side of the yard, which had recently been picked clean of fruit. He didn't see the abundant fruit because he was looking in the wrong place!

Like Fr. Bob, we sadly don't see the fruit all around us. We think that the culture is spiraling down, young people avoid church, and the future looks bleak.

Why go out into the world and work?
The world looks like a fruitless tree.

Jesus doesn't see things that way. This week he tells us, **"The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few."**

Look again: there is spiritual fruit hanging all around us!

The lonely ready to be visited. The sick ready to be healed. The forgotten ready to be remembered. The poor ready to be treated with dignity. The sad ready to be consoled. The young ready for the Gospel.

So, let's ask the Lord to send laborers to get to work. And he will. He might send you and me. Just remember to look at the correct trees. — *Father John Muir*




