





Religious Education

Dear Friends and Families of Saint James,

Exciting things await in Religious Education this fall!

Registration for the 2023-2024 school year opened this past Wednesday, July 12th, and families have a choice between our Traditional Faith Formation Program and our new and expanded Family Faith Formation Program.

Traditional Faith Formation will take place on Tuesdays during the school year from 4-5:15pm at the Parish Center. Traditional classes are what Religious Education has always offered and will follow a curriculum from Saint Mary's Press.

Our new **Family Faith Formation** will have two components. The first will be family sessions held in person for the whole family about once a month for an hour and a half on a Sunday afternoon at Saint James School. The second will be family sessions held by each family in their home about twice a month with support from the Office of Religious Education and the great kits that we will provide each family.

We are adding the Family Faith Formation Program this year to provide another way for us to support our parish families who seek to raise children of faith. The Catholic Church teaches that parents are the primary educators in the faith—families are where children first experience God's love through the love given freely to them by their parents.

And all the research (and there really is research on this!) tells us that the key to effective Catholic parenting is to empower parents to authentically and intentionally communicate the faith to their children.

So why are we adding this program to the RE offerings for 2023-2024? Because Family Faith Formation works! It's a big change, but we invite all parish families to join us on this journey. We believe it will bear much fruit.

And of course, we still need parishioners who want to live out their baptismal call by serving in one of our Religious Education programs.

We can help you discern which program fits your gifts, so please contact the office so we can start you on the path to be prepared to minister with children this September.

Remember, there are many ways to help the families of the parish as they raise children of faith, and our programs are open to all parish families, regardless of where your children attend school. Some activities will occur just once during the year. Other activities occur monthly, twice a month, or weekly.

You can share your gifts with the community in the following programs for parish children and families:

- Traditional Faith Formation classes (Catechists, Aides, Yard Duty, Yard Monitors)
- Family Faith Formation (Catechists, Mentors, Aides)
- Sacramental Preparation (Catechists, Aides)
- Children's RCIA
- Children's Liturgy of the Word (twice a month at the 10am Mass)
- Family Day of Service Coordinators
- Family Field Trip Coordinators
- Family Faith Formation Experiences for Advent and Lent, like last year's Morning in Bethlehem (single day events)

Please call our office at **310.379.3221** for more information about our programs or to learn more about how to get involved.

Also, the Office of Religious Education will be hosting the **Second Annual Family Field Trip**. This year, we will visit the **Cathedral of Our Lady of Angels on Saturday, August 26**th, **at 9am**; docents will lead our tour. **We are limited to 40 participants, so registration is required**. Families will need to arrange their own transportation. Please plan to meet our group in the courtyard outside the Cathedral at 8:45am.

Grandparents, Godparents, and families are all welcome! Please call the Office to register.

Last week, we held a Summer Family Day of Service with the Saint James Feed the Needy Program. The youth and their families had a wonderful experience serving lunch to the hungry in our community. They all said they'd love to come back, so we have added another day! If your family would like to participate, we will hold another Family Day of Service on Wednesday, August 9, from 12-2. Please call the Office to register. Remember, we are limited to 10 participants and parents (or grandparents and Godparents) must attend with children, so call soon! We will fill up quickly!

Most of us are ready to take a break from the challenges we have faced these past many months.




Men from our parish are invited to make their annual retreat at Mater Dolorosa Retreat center in Sierra Madre.

Invite Someone to Mass

The church is again open for quiet prayer from 7am-7pm daily.

Our daily Mass is at 8 am and 12 noon Monday-Friday with the rosary prayed immediately afterward.

Our **Saturday Mass is at 8am.** Help others attend Mass and receive the Eucharist; the true body and blood of Christ hidden in the form of a host.

Catholic Q&A Topic: Words and Music

Opening the Bible to about the middle of the book, just after the trials and triumph of Job and before the wise instructive Proverbs will place the reader among scripture which the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* calls:

" ...the masterwork of prayer in the Old Testament."

Q: To what does the *Catechism* refer? **A:** The *Catechism* refers to The Book Of Psalms; Hebrew Psalter numbers 1-150.

Q: How does the dictionary define the word Psalm? **A:** We find that according to the dictionary, a psalm is a sacred song or poem. The Hebrew word, psalm, scholars tell us, is "from the root term "to pluck" as in plucking of fruit or plucking a stringed instrument."

Q: What's the difference between a psalm, and a canticle?

A: The word canticle is the diminutive of the Latin words, "canticum" and "canticulum" meaning song.

A canticle is not so much different in musical style from a psalm, but a psalm is found only in the Book of Psalms, and canticles are found elsewhere in scripture.

Q: Which are the most popular Psalms? **A:** Each psalm is a treasure, and popularity would mostly be a subjective concept, but one list gives us Psalms: 23, 91, 139, and 27 as among the most esteemed and revered of Psalms.

The Choir and general assembly of the faithful sings these Psalms, from #23 the Lord as shepherd, to Psalm 91,"...my God in whom I trust; under the shelter of his wings."

In the spirit of Psalms being sung by a full, active assembly, we have all sung Psalm 139,

"Lord you know me and you search me; ever the maker and keeper of my days..."


And we've sung in wistful tones, Psalm 27,

" One thing I ask;

to dwell in the house of the Lord all my days."

Biblical sources tell us that the Psalms are the product of many individual collections, with seventy-three Psalms attributed to David. They are, in words and music, from lamentation to greatest joy, vital elements of liturgical worship.

'Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will also help you,



I will also uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Is. 41:10

Gospel Meditation

It's not uncommon to hear people complain that we Catholics often fail in communicating our faith.

Fair enough. We can and should improve there. But it's interesting to notice that Jesus himself was implicitly accused by his disciples of a similar failure. This week in Matthew's gospel they are perplexed that he speaks to the crowds in ambiguous parables.

The Lord's riddles leave many people more confused than before. He responds by pointing out that his parables have an intentional dual purpose: to hide (for some) and to reveal (for others) his Gospel:

"Because knowledge of the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven has been granted to you, but to them it has not been granted"

(Matthew 13:11). Is Jesus being unnecessarily difficult, obscurantist, or, worse, elitist?

No. We have to remember that all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge lie hidden in him (c.f., Col. 2:3). He is the word of God from heaven to be planted in the earth of our humanity to bear great fruit. However, like a lover delicately pursuing his beloved, we're dealing with a *relationship*, not new data. When we aren't willing to personally accept Jesus into our lives, the "info" of the Gospel will simply not make sense to us. It'll seem bizarre, esoteric, or like incoherent religious-speak. But when we are willing to accept Jesus into our lives, everything else starts to make sense. When others don't understand the Church or the Lord, let's be patient. Love is patient. Sometimes it has to hide before it is revealed. — Father John Muir
