Religious Education

Dear Friends and Families of Saint James,

Registration for the 2023-2024 school year is open, and families have a choice between our Traditional Faith Formation Program and our new and expanded Family Faith Formation Program.

Please visit our page of the parish website to register: www.saintjames.church/re

Traditional Faith Formation will take place on Tuesdays during the school year from 4-5:15pm at the Parish Center. Traditional classes are what Religious Education has always offered and will follow a curriculum from Saint Mary's Press.

Our new **Family Faith Formation** will have two components:

- The first will be family sessions held in person for the whole family about once a month for an hour and a half on a Sunday afternoon at Saint James School.
- The second will be family sessions held by each family in their home about twice a month with support from the Office of Religious Education and the great kits that we will provide each family.

We are adding the Family Faith Formation Program this year to provide another way for us to support our parish families who seek to raise children of faith.

The Catholic Church teaches that parents are the primary educators in the faith—families are where children first experience God's love through the love given freely to them by their parents.

And all the research (and there really is research on this!) tells us that the key to effective Catholic parenting is to empower parents to authentically and intentionally communicate the faith to their children.

So why are we adding this program to the RE offerings for 2023-2024? Because Family Faith Formation works! It's a big change, but we invite all parish families to join us on this journey. We believe it will bear much fruit.

And of course, we still need parishioners who want to live out their baptismal call by serving in one of our Religious Education programs.

We can help you discern which program fits your gifts, so please contact the office so we can start you on the path to be prepared to minister with children this September.

Remember, there are many ways to help the families of the parish as they raise children of faith, and our programs are open to all parish families, regardless of where your children attend school. Some activities will occur just once during the year. Other activities occur monthly, twice a month, or weekly

You can share your gifts with the community in the following programs for parish children and families:



Catholic Q & A

Catholic Q&A Topic: The Glory and the Honor

Among the readings this week, we can appreciate the Old Testament Book of Chronicles I and II.

Sources say that the literary purpose of these books of Biblical history serves to "disclose the action of the living God in human affairs," The more than 500 years covered in Chronicles, from the death of Saul to the return from exile, find the followers of David and Solomon focused on what Bible scholars describe as "true worship of the Lord."

1 Chronicles 29 marks the tone of that worship: "And now our God, we give **thanks** to you and **praise** your glorious name."

These days the Mass finds us honoring the Gloria, (omitted during the penitential days of Lent,) as we continue to offer the ancient, enduring thanks and praise in alleluias to the Lord.

Q: What does the word Alleluia mean, and do repeated, soaring Hallelujahs as in Handel's Messiah have the same meaning?

A: The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops tell us that the word alleluia is a derivative of a Hebrew phrase meaning "Praise the Lord" and most literally translates as "Praise God." Another source discusses the frequently interchangeable use of these terms, and points out that the etymology of the word hallelujah has origins in the Hebrew language, and that the word alleluia is from the Greek.


The Catechism of the Catholic Church in Paragraph 1081 talks about divine blessings and our response of praise and thanksgiving made manifest by way of the "astonishing and saving events" of salvation law and fulfilling prophecy.

Celebrating the action of "the living God in human affairs," the St. James Choir sings a Dan Schutte song of thanks: "Glory and praise to our God who alone gives light to our days..."



The Alleluia is all about worship of the Lord...Hallelujah!

'Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will also help you,



I will also uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Is. 41:10

Gospel Meditation

Our culture seems more polarized and divided than ever.

Into this wounded situation, our Catholic faith has a healing remedy to offer: the gift of wisdom.

When the Lord offers to give King Solomon anything the monarch desires, he requests "an understanding heart" (1 Kings 3:9).

In his polarized situation, the King doesn't ask for power to defeat his enemies. He asks for a wise and understanding heart to judge right from wrong. This wisdom is elevated and fulfilled in Jesus who teaches us to bring forth "both the new and the old" (Matthew 13:52).

In our fractured society, we Christians should stop pining for political power to crush our perceived enemies. That often just makes things worse. Rather, it's much more useful to beg for the grace of true wisdom which transcends both sides of the aisle. This places us in a fresh position from which we can help our culture see what is true and good all across the ideological spectrum. Sometimes we'll look like liberals (e.g., in our love for the poor and marginalized) and other times like conservatives (e.g., in our sexual ethics and views on religious freedom). Because this wisdom is free from ideological narrowness, it will help to heal these painful fractures.

Lord Jesus, this week, pour into us your healing wisdom. — Father John Muir


