### Pastor's Letter

### Fr. Paul Kuunuba's Update and Letter

Father Paul Kuunuba from the diocese of Damongo, Ghana, was with us on sabbatical from August last year until the end of January, following the completion of his studies in Rome. When he returned to Ghana he was assigned in charge of the Youth Programs for the diocese as well as the director of the Diocesan shrine.



On the feast of St. James (July 25<sup>th</sup>) he wrote to me and said, "In the last two weeks I hosted 120 youth, delegates from the 13 parishes of the diocese for the Annual General Council meeting of the youth. It was a three-day program. But it went on well. Now I am organizing again a pilgrimage to our shrine, Our Lady of the Annunciation Grotto for the solemnity of the Assumption of Mary on August 15<sup>th</sup>. It is always fulfilling after the struggles and challenges in organizing, to see people happy at the end."

When Fr. Paul left we were able to send him \$10,000 through the generous support of parishioners as well as a \$5,000 gift from the parish.

To the parish, Fr. Paul also wrote a letter:

#### A Word of Gratitude

I write once again to express my sincerest gratitude to you and indeed the entire parish family of St. James Church, Redondo Beach. I wish to acknowledge in a special way your love and affection towards me during my mini sabbatical stay in your parish in the United States. Your fatherly care, concern and support cannot be forgotten. And more to that, the financial support given me to assist me in my ministry in this part of the world where though the church is still going through the phases of primary evangelization is required to be self-reliant. This financial support has indeed come to get me into my ministry. I cannot say enough of my appreciation to you.

On a similar vein, I wish to express my thankfulness through you to the entire parishioners of St. James Church for their various contributions to me during my stay there and after I left. I received with gratitude their contributions through you. May the good Lord richly bless each and every one of them for whatever they have done for me.

Lastly but not the least, to the parish staff, Frs. James Kavanagh and Thaddeus Agbasonu as well as Deacon Bob and Patty and all those at the parish offices. I appreciate each and every one of them and their diverse contributions and support for me. May the good Lord bless you all. May St. James whose feast we celebrate never cease to intercede for you.

### Anointing of the Sick Sunday, Aug. 13<sup>th</sup> from 1:30-2:30pm in church

Jesus came to heal the whole person, body and soul

In the Church's Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them from sin – and sometimes even from physical ailment. His cures were signs of the arrival of the Kingdom of God. The core message of his healing tells us of his plan to conquer sin and death by his dying and rising. The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.







### Catholic Q&A Topic: The Soul of Sacred Theology

In a recent early morning Sunday Mass, Father Thaddeus was considering the richness and relevance of sacred scripture.

Even in that 6:30 AM time frame, the value of the Gospels was made clearly evident.

The Catholic Bishops tell us that the word "gospel" translates the Greek term *euangelion*, meaning "good news" and one of the elements of that news which Father pointed out, was that the good news is part of God's plan, setting us along the path that leads to our formation as "God's chosen people."

The Catechism says: "The Church forcefully and specifically exhorts all the Christian faithful to learn the surpassing knowledge of Jesus Christ by frequent reading of the divine Scriptures. Therefore, the study of the sacred page should be the very soul of sacred theology...

Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ."

The Catholic Bishops advise:

"If scripture remains just words on a page, our work is not done. We need to meditate on the message and put it into action in our lives. Only then can the word be living and effective."

Pope Francis writes:

"...listen to the word of God, meditate on it, pray with it. Be constantly nourished by the Word Of God!"

Our Patron, Saint James, puts it like this: "Be doers of the Word and not hearers only..."

We all have our favorite Bible verses, some we know from memory and hold deeply within our heart.

One favorite verse from the Gospels comes from Luke 11: "...seek and you will find..."

What is Christianity finally about?


These days if you ask almost anyone who doesn't know the Bible you'll probably hear an answer like this: "Being a good person" or "following the golden rule."

It's about lives open (or closed) to transfiguration, lives capable of revealing the glory of God in Christ to the world. Spouses, children, friends, co-workers, priests, consecrated women and men, and so on — we are all called to let the beauty of Jesus make our lives beautiful, little by little.


