As the death toll from the devastating wildfires on the island of Maui, Hawaii continues to climb, officials have confirmed that this to be the deadliest disaster in the state's history. In a telegram addressed to the Apostolic Nuncio to the United States, Pope Francis expressed his deep sadness at "the loss of life and the destruction caused by the wildfires" in Hawaii and assured those affected by the fires of his prayers. Archbishop Gomez has asked all parishes to consider conducting a non-mandatory special collection during the weekends of August 19-20 and August 26-27, 2023.

We hope you will join us on our Second Annual Family Field Trip this coming Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup>, at 9am, when we will visit the Cathedral of Our Lady of Angels. We will have two options for families this year, Traditional Faith Formation and Family Faith Formation.

**Traditional Faith Formation** will be on Tuesdays from **4:15--5:30pm** at the Parish Center (please note the NEW TIME). Traditional classes are what Religious Education has always offered and will follow a curriculum from Saint Mary's Press.

Family Faith Formation will include sessions held for the whole family about once a month for an hour and a half on a Sunday afternoon at Saint James School, as well as family sessions held by each family in their home about twice a month with support from the Office of Religious Education and the great kits that we will provide each family.

We are adding the Family Faith Formation Program this year to provide another way for us to support our parish families who seek to raise children of faith. The Catholic Church teaches that parents are the primary educators in the faith—families are where children first experience God's love through the love given freely to them by their parents. And research tells us that the key to effective Catholic parenting is to empower parents to authentically and intentionally communicate the faith to their children.

So we are adding this program to the RE offerings for 2023-2024 because Family Faith Formation works! It's a big change, but we invite all parish families to join us on this journey. We believe it will bear much fruit.

Thanks, also, to those families who joined us for our second **Summer Family Day of Service** on Wednesday, August 9<sup>th</sup>. The children and parents served our hungry neighbors with our St. James **Feed the Needy** program and found joy in the experience.

### Catholic Q&A Topic: Mother of Mercy

Q: What can be said about the Holy Rosary?

A: There is much that can be said:

- It's a scripture-based prayer.
- Pope Pius XII observed: "...its very origin and the wisdom of its composition is more divine than human."
- It's a devotional, meditative prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary.
- Pope St. John Paul II described this devotional prayer as, "a compendium of the whole Gospel."
- Pope St. Paul VI said that this prayer is, " ...a reflection of the principle acts of our redemption."
- Pope Leo XIII, the so-called "Rosary Pope" in the late nineteenth century wrote nine encyclicals on this set of devotional prayers and the spiritual benefits to be derived.
- The Church of the Most Holy Trinity, in Trinity, Texas writes: "So what we are doing in the Rosary is recalling the chief mysteries of our faith, in a manner taught us by a loving Mother."

Scripture presents that loving Mother as a woman of few words, who, in the ancient city of Cana, in Galilee, was present at the Lord's first recorded miracle in the transforming of water into wine.

Mary, in John Chapter 2: "Do whatever He tells you to do." In Luke Chapter 2 it is noted that Mary, "...kept all these things close to her heart."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches in Paragraph 2682: "...the Church loves to pray in communion with the Virgin Mary..."

The Hail Holy Queen, (Salve Regina,) portion of the prayers of the Rosary refers to our struggles and hopes here in this "valley of tears."

The faithful continually call upon a mother of mercy, our gracious advocate to "show unto us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus."

And so it is that amid the beads and decades of the Holy Rosary, our loving mother Mary leads us to Jesus.

We keep these things close to our hearts.

### **Gospel Meditation**

The suffering of a child symbolizes uniquely terrible evil as well as despair about the future.

This week's Gospel gives a "limit" case in which Jesus encounters this evil in the form of a mother with a suffering daughter.

What he does is stunning and massively helpful for us if we bravely ponder the details.

The Canaanite woman comes to Jesus and begs his mercy.

"My daughter is tormented by a demon,"

she declares to him. Shockingly, he responds first with silence, then with a dismissive comment, and only then finally accedes to her third request.

Is this simply a lesson in perseverance in our petitions to God, who is like a genie in a bottle?

Does that justify the humiliation and pain this woman suffers?

Is the Lord cruel?

I don't think so. Notice how the encounter ends.

She compares herself to a dog at the table of a master. Jesus responds by praising her great faith and fulfills her deep desire.

Somehow this non-Israelite woman intuits that this harrowing situation is not dumb suffering.

She senses that the door of God's family is, in Jesus, being opened to her and her loved ones.

She trusts she is at the Lord's table, and her desires will be fulfilled and that all her sufferings — and her daughter's, too — will lead a great banquet.

In our sufferings this week, the Lord wants us to treat him less like a genie in a bottle and more like the Master who has taken us — lost little dogs that we are — into his home forever.

Trust that and keep praying in the face of evil.






