Pastor's Letter

St. James Master Plan Update

In December, 2021, Bishop Trudeau, the San Pedro Regional Bishop, approved our request for the sale of the current St. James Parish Center/Parish Office/ Preschool property on the east side of Pacific Coast Highway. The sale was proposed to pay the Archdiocese the remaining mortgage on the purchase of the new "Broadway" property and help towards the construction of a new parish center, parish offices and preschool on that site.

Since then, the sale of the property was reviewed and approved by the Archdiocesan Real Estate Committee, the Construction Committee, the College of Consultors, the Archdiocesan Finance Council and the archbishop. The property was listed by the ACC Real Estate office, a buyer was selected, and finally, Rome approved the sale in May, 2023. The Archdiocese has entered into a 24 month escrow with a developer for \$12.5 million. Escrow should close in early 2025. The current mortgage with the archdiocese is for \$5.6 million.

In anticipation of the sale of the property, the archdiocese assigned our project manager. In July of 2022, we sent out 10 Requests for Proposal for Design Services and eventually met with 7 architects. After a second round of interviews our selection team all agreed that we would like to work with Mr. Charles Kluger. In July, 2023, the buyer's due diligence period was completed and the agreed down payment of the sale was made. With the sale of the property established, it was now time to finalize plans for the development of the new 'Broadway Parish Center' property. Mr. Kluger has presented his contract and after review and approval by the Archdiocese it was signed this past week.

We will not have the funds to begin construction until escrow closes (January, 2025), so we would hope to start construction as soon after that as possible. During this time we will work earnestly with Mr. Kluger on the needs and architectural design of our new facilities and submit our plans to the City of Redondo Beach and the Archdiocese.

It is amazing how long this project has taken so far, but all that we are doing is constantly being reviewed for our safety. The Archdiocesan offices have been an invaluable part of this process and will continue to assist us to ensure that we are making the best decisions for the future of St. James.

Depending on how smoothly the process goes, we hope to complete construction by mid-2026.





Catholic Q&A Topic: Begin Anew

Each year, as part of a prelude to a new school term, the history teacher would present his yearly, "clean slate" lesson to his classes.

The teaching was about renewed beginnings, offering each student a measure of encouragement and direction, reminding that no matter the prior struggles, chaos, or circumstances, that each student, through dedication, patience and effort, could expect to achieve results of advanced proficiency; they could, as it were, "get it right."

Q: Now it's a long way across time and space between an obscure teacher, now retired, and his first day 8th graders of the 21st century, and St. Paul's Letter To The Colossians, which scholars tell us was written sometime between A.D. 60-62, but there are some possible parallels. What parallels?

A: History tells us that the letter from Paul was addressed to a congregation in Colossae in Asia Minor at a chaotic time when certain proclaimers of the faith were presenting false doctrine about the redemptive power of Christ, and other matters of faith. Paul 's epistle was seeking to offer true and corrective teaching and encouragement to that far-away Christian community in order that they "get it right,"

Our eighth graders were being taught about renewal, possibilities and patience, while Paul's Letter Chapter 3, talks about a renewal of faith and authentic teaching on a higher spiritual plane: "..you have taken off the old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed ...put on then...patience..."

Matthew Kelly's book, *Resisting Happiness*, also teaches about expectations and the ways in which we may become the best version of ourselves. In Chapter 28 of that book we meet St. Francis de Sales and his teachings, applicable to Christians in an ancient world setting, yet with a message fully applicable as well to modern day students and to all of us seeking to spiritually and generally, "get it right" as well:

"Have patience with all things, but chiefly have patience with yourself. Do not lose courage in considering your own imperfections but instantly set about redeeming them ---every day begin anew."

One scholar, underscores here the valuable teachings of the *Catechism:* "*The Catechism* is an indispensable arm of instruction on every level..."

All teachers labor to teach well in their quest for positive results; a kind of 'harvest' of results.

Matthew 9, "...ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." All of us labor in cultivating our particular harvest of hope, faith, and personal renewal.

With patience, a bountiful yield of faith will abound.

Gospel Meditation

Isn't it a bit weird that Catholics call the Pope "papa," father?

This Sunday provides us with essential Scriptural background on the papacy, the petrine office. Jesus gives Peter the "keys to the kingdom of heaven," after witnessing to the special grace Peter has to know Jesus' true identity. Many



have pointed out that the "keys" refer back to the figure of Eliakim, King David's prime minister. True enough. But notice this is not mere authority or power. It's a family relationship. The Lord says to Eliakim, "He shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem" (Isaiah 22:21). David's prime minister was a spiritual *father* to the family of Israel. Peter, and his successors, will be spiritual fathers in the family of the Church.

This means we have a serious obligation to not only recognize the Pope's authority, but also to love him with the affection of children for their papa. We should never speak about him with disrespect or rancor. We should listen to him with trusting hearts, and ignore the slander thrown at him in various media. When we show the world we are loving and obedient to our Holy Papa, perhaps they'll see more clearly that the Church is indeed God's beloved family. — Father John Muir


