Catholic Q&A Topic: We Pray to the Lord

Catholic Bishops tell us that sometime between the 7th and the 5th centuries, B.C. that the Old Testament Book of Job was written, perhaps by its namesake, perhaps not. This Biblical, wonderfully literary work of prose and poetry is categorized as didactic in form, yet this sort of instruction is beautifully, inspirationally, even viscerally instructive.

The story of the stricken, yet worthy Job and his cadre of friends including: Zophar, Eliphaz, Bildad, (and later, Elihu and Esau), describes timeless discussion concerning the nature and the challenges of *suffering*.

Someone once said that the answer to Job's seemingly unanswerable questions about suffering may ultimately only be found, " ... somewhere in the vastness of the universe..."

Q: What does the Church teach about the vicissitudes of suffering?

A: The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that: "Illness and suffering have always been among the gravest problems confronted in human life. Illness can lead to anguish, self-absorption, sometimes even despair and revolt against God."

Catechism Entry #1501: "It, (suffering), can also make a person more mature, helping discern in life what is essential so as to turn toward that which is. Very often illness provokes a search for God and a return to him." The Catechism quotes Exodus 15: "...for I, the Lord, am your healer."

The Bible, the Catechism, and the lives of the Saints teach us about the value of prayer in the face of suffering. Here at St. James we publish and also announce prayer intentions for the sick at Mass; our entreaties go into the Parish Books of Intercession, our Priests and Deacon and Bereavement Ministry and additional ministries provide solace as we as a Catholic family seek to help and comfort one another in the seasons of suffering.

Job's own intention to remain faithfully steadfast in all his trials, endures, and prospers once again, yet the Catholic Bishops remind us that the Book of Job,"... does not definitively answer the problem of the suffering of the innocent, but challenges readers to come to their own understanding."

Together we can meet that challenge. We recognize a supreme God and seek to prayerfully endure the challenges of suffering. And, in the silence of our heart, we continue to ponder the ways of our faith, "across the vastness of the universe."

Lord, hear our prayer...

Gospel Meditation

Isn't it easy to relate to Peter?

One moment Jesus announces Peter's deep communion with God the Father. The very next, when he rejects the logic of Jesus' suffering and death, Jesus calls Peter Satan.

We 0Christians shouldn't be too shocked when we experience both spiritual highs and lows, when we perceive breathtaking contradictions in our hearts.

Like the great apostle, you and I are recipients of unfathomable graces. God dwells in us, calls his beloved children, and takes care of our every need. And we also continually fail to embrace our sufferings with trust in Jesus. We know the truth of the creed, but we easily scorn the weight of the cross.

The good news is that, like Peter, we are never abandoned by the Lord even at our worst moments. Peter will eventually learn the beauty of the cross when he is willingly crucified. But it took time for him to get there. And it takes time for us, too. This week let's not be too shocked at these divisions in our hearts but accept them and patiently seek to be more obedient to Jesus' cross-shaped plan for us. — Father John Muir
