





St. Michael Prayer

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle;

The church is again open for quiet prayer from 7am- 7pm daily.

Our daily Mass is at 8 am and 12 noon Monday-Friday with the rosary prayed immediately afterward.

Our **Saturday Mass is at 8am.** Help others attend Mass and receive the Eucharist; the true body and blood of Christ hidden in the form of a host.

Catholic Q&A Topic: In Imitation of Christ

In a Sunday homily, Monsignor Mike was explaining about putting God first; bearing our individual crosses while putting the Cross of Jesus at the center of a life of faith.

Q: Who among the Saints is considered an example, par excellence, of service, marked by an elevated life of humbly authentic, Cross-centered faith?

A: As we continue to mark the progression of the ordered days of the Church's liturgical calendar, there comes a feast day on October 4th of an extraordinary Italian, re-named Francis by his merchant father, living their days in the medieval town of Assisi. This saint is a shining example of what the Catholic Bishops define as someone who bears the Cross, which represents faith, by

"putting his trust in God...laying ego aside."

Francis, in his conversion, puts into practice the scripture passage which says,

"...whoever does not bear his cross and come after me cannot be my disciple." After living his youthful days amid worldly pleasures, biographies of Francis recall his wild days and his military service. One incident in his life describes Francis hearing Christ in a vision:

"Go, Francis, and repair my house, which as you see is falling into ruin."

What followed was a life of voluntary poverty, establishment of the Franciscan Order, service to the Church, and unceasing care of the poor, the outcast, and the infirmed. Francis is Patron saint of animals, ecology, and merchants.

Pope Francis, speaking about his namesake, and the entire "cloud of witnesses", said that the saints were not born perfect, but rather,

"are ordinary people who followed God with all their heart."

Visiting priest Father John Callanan, at Mass, often cites the Irish Bishops in his prayers about the wonders of God's creation:

"Lord we thank you for the rocks and the trees, the rivers and the fields..."

Pope Francis is always appreciative of the spirit of God in the environment:

"As stewards of God's creation, we are called to make the earth a beautiful garden for the human family..."

And St. Francis himself, dedicated to worshipping at the Cross of Jesus:

"Praised be you, my Lord, through Sister Earth our Mother who sustains and governs us."

At the cross, ordinary people, keeping God's house from ever falling into ruin. Following God with all our heart.

Gospel Meditation

What are you supposed to do about the **bad behavior** of the people around you?

You know who I'm talking about. That family member, friend, coworker, or acquaintance who is quite immoral. On this front there are two lively options in our culture: bash the person to others (probably online) or pretend everything's fine. The former damages the person. The latter ignores reality. What to do?

Jesus' strategy in the Gospel of Matthew is as wise as it is difficult: go directly to the person, and then gradually expand the circle of intervention.

Simple, often effective, and hard. But what we often miss is the context of the Lord's strategy,

"If your brother sins against you..."

Notice the italicized words. Is the person in a Christian familial bond with you? And was the action in question against *you*? If so, proceed with the plan. Fine.

But how often we fret over the sins of those who either aren't our spiritual siblings or have done nothing directly to us. This is not an invitation to ignore injustice in the world. Rather, we should build bonds of fraternal love, and carefully discern when and how others' sins are indeed our concern. Sometimes they are. Other times — frequently, perhaps — they simply are not.




