As chancellor of the Diocese of Kumbo, Rev. Eugen had much to do with the work and personnel of the Lay Mission-Helpers.

On this day, catechists are formally commissioned for ministry to the community.

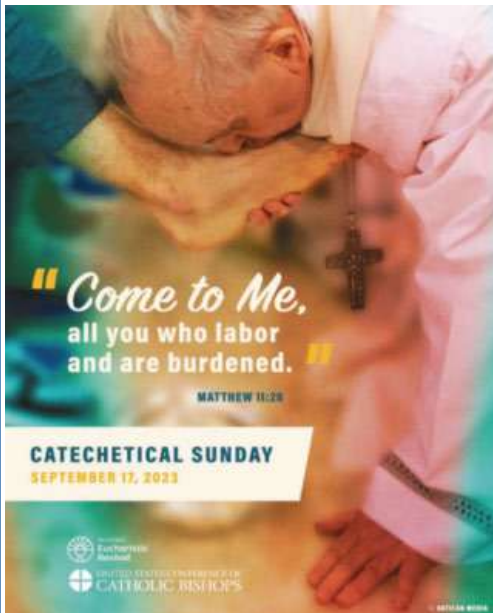
Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each baptized person plays in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel.

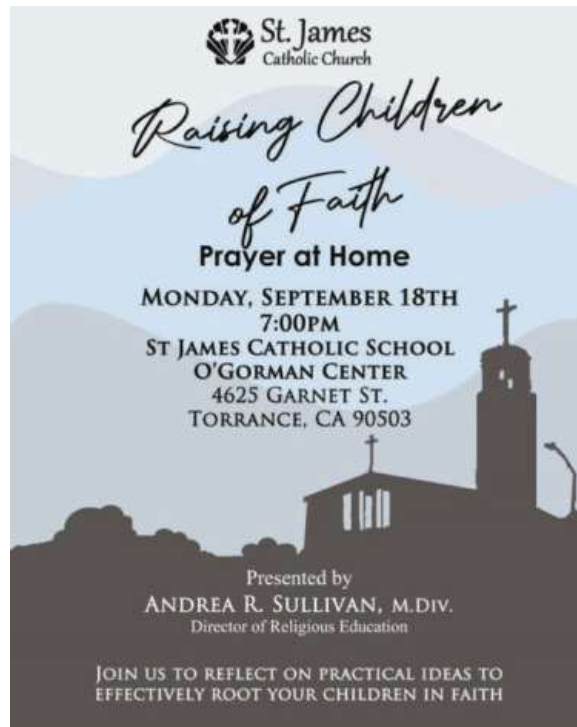

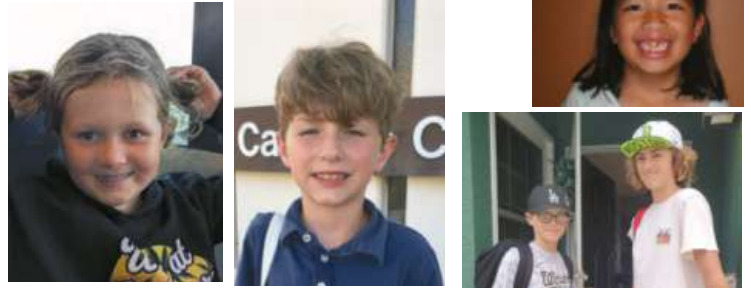
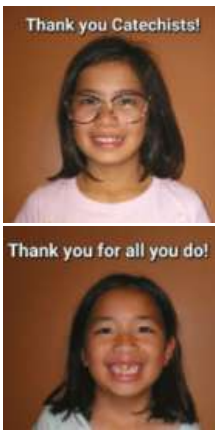

Catholic Q&A Topic: Chapter and Verse

Q: What does the *Catechism's* instruction say about Sacred Scripture?

A: Browsing through *The Catechism of the Catholic Church*, the parishioner was in the section called "The Profession of Faith." The entries there were focused on Sacred Scripture in the life of the Church. There were many descriptive, easy to digest, inspirational teachings, such as:

"Therefore, the study of the sacred page should be the very soul of sacred theology."

"The Sacred Scriptures contain the word of God..."
"God is the author of Sacred Scripture because he inspired the human authors..."

"Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ."

In consideration of this aspect of our spiritual journey, the reader thought about some of his own favorite readings. Here he notes five excerpts:

1. "Listen..." *Proverbs 19* can be distilled to that one key word; crucial in practice to Catholic adults and students as well. Father Thaddeus spoke in his Sunday Homily about putting our Catholic faith into actual practice. So, we listen.

2. "Let all that you do be done in love." *1 Corinthians 16*; a true guiding faith principle. This excerpt also falls under Father's Sunday teachings, stressing the abiding commandment to practice true love of neighbor by Christ's examples.

3. "Do what is right..." *Proverbs 15*. This "go to" beacon of light is great as an ordering starting point of faith practice.

4. "He will calm you in His love..." *Zephaniah 3:17* provides solace in times of trial.

5. "Trust in the Lord and do good." *Psalms 37*, a superior internal and external compass.

These scripture readings are what the *Catechism* calls, "food for the soul."

When I was in second grade, my prized possession was a metal Star Wars-themed lunch box.

After school one day, another student ripped it from my hands. I helplessly watched in horror as my classmate threw it to the ground and violently stomped it into an unrecognizable heap of junk. I came home covered in tears of shame and rage. After a few months, I never thought about it again ... until I was almost thirty years old and on a retreat to prepare for ordination to the priesthood.

That childhood memory — and the attendant outrage — came back afresh. My spiritual director helped me in the process of acknowledging that I was angry because that kid *owed* me my lunch box. Then she helped me, through the grace of Jesus, to forgive the debt. Almost immediately I felt a new peace. I was amazed that I hadn't forgotten what I had lost, even from years before. Aren't we human beings simply amazing at remembering what people owe us?

We see this week in Jesus' parable a servant who is forgiven much but then commands another servant: "Pay back what you owe!" He can't forget or let go of how he was wronged. He *remembers* — and he becomes a monster because of it. If only he had remembered not only the debts owed to him, but also his greater debt owed to — and forgiven by — his master. It's natural for us to remember what others owe us. But when we contextualize those offenses in Jesus' mercy toward us and them, we're free to be merciful like the Master and less like a monster who never forgets.

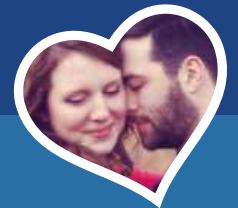

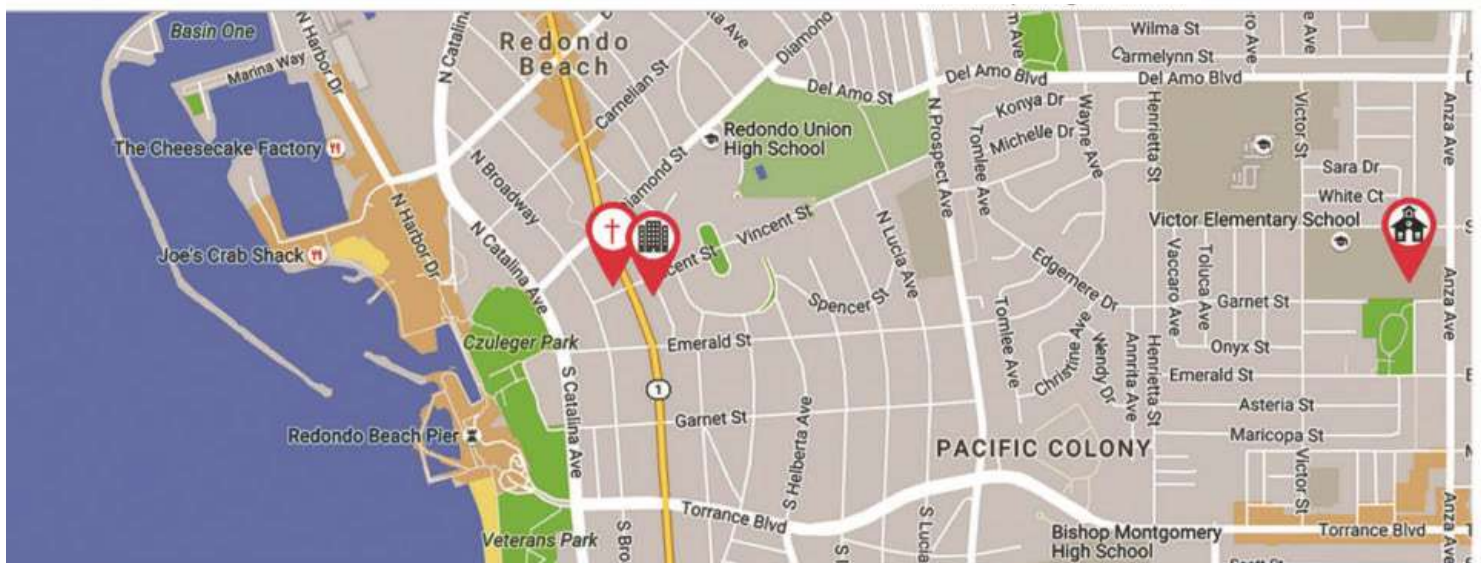
