same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money?



Why it is important not to dismiss a child's everyday emotions?

A key part of creating a safe environment is being a trusted adult to the children in your care. Children who have been abused are more likely to confide in a trusted adult whom they know will listen to and believe them.

For this reason, it is important to affirm a child's everyday emotions, including anger or fear. Far too often, adults tell children "you're fine," or "get over it," in response to what a child perceives as a true emotional problem, but an adult may see as an inconvenience or insignificant event.

Affirming a child's feelings while still helping them work through their issue productively will help create a bond of trust. For more

Catholic Q&A Topic: Encyclical Letter of Recommendation

After receiving Birthday wishes from friends and family, an inspired parishioner thought about that kindness, friendship, and the action of the Holy Spirit at work among the realms that call each of us to "love thy neighbor," as in John 13:

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

Our priests regularly talk about putting the Good News into practice, as does our Pope. In October of 2020, in an Encyclical, Pope Francis wrote addressing all Catholic disciples around the world, (quite a Contacts list), that they should continue to put into practice, Holy Scripture as exemplified by the 11th Century friar, St .Francis.

Pope Francis signed this 8 chapter Encyclical in the town of Assisi, calling for, "a just and peaceful world." He also invoked the spiritual and practical example of the Good Samaritan."

This encyclical letter is titled in Italian, *Fratelli Tutti*, meaning "all brothers, or all brothers and sisters." The theme of this Papal letter is described as fraternity and social friendship.

Q: What does the *Catechism* say about the kind of love that Pope Francis describes, where one decides whether to be Good Samaritans or indifferent bystanders?

A: Among many entries, Paragraph 1931 puts this idea of active, fraternal, loving discipleship in clear terms:

"...everyone should look upon his neighbor, (without any exception), as another self."

Gospel Meditation

Once I gave my three-year-old niece a certain toy for Christmas.

When she opened it, she was happy. Shortly thereafter her five-year old sister opened another present from me: the same toy, along with some play jewelry. The three-year-old cried out:

"That's not fair! Why'd she get the jewelry, too?!"

Let's face it: there's something about God's grace in our religion which bugs us. We love to look at others' blessings and cry out:

"That's not fair!"

Catholicism is not fair in the sense that it is a religion founded on God's grace which is *unmerited* favor. God pours his mercy, love, and divine life upon us not because we're good but because He is infinitely good.

If you think the "not fair" quality of grace is easy to accept, consider how typically angry we get when we hear the parable of the workers who get paid way more than they deserve. The hyper-generous landowner says to the indignant hard workers,

"Are you envious because I am generous?"

Well, yes, they are, and so are we! Therefore, we *have* to reckon with this painful truth in order to move into the divine sphere of gifts, which is the world of Christ and his Church. Then we are able to move beyond a tit-for-tat world and into one where gifts are poured forth on those who don't deserve it — namely upon us.


