

Pastor's Letter

St. James Seminary Intern now Bishop Albert Bahhuth

In 1995, a young seminarian Albert Bahhuth was assigned to St. James for his Pastoral Internship under the direction of Fr. Tim Nichols. But he was no 'ordinary' seminarian. Born in Beirut, Lebanon in 1956, he came to the U.S. in 1976. After receiving B.S., M.S. and



Doctorate in Chemical Engineering, he moved to Los Angeles in 1984. He soon found his calling to priesthood and entered St. John's Seminary in 1991.

Ordained in 1996 he served in several parishes until 2015 when he was selected to be the Vicar General (COO) of the Archdiocese where he served until 2020. After 3 years as Pastor of Holy Family Church, South Pasadena, he was called to become an auxiliary bishop for Los Angeles in July. His ordination as bishop was this past week, Sept. 26th, at the Cathedral.

Thanks to many of our 'old timers' who helped in his formation back in 1995. We are happy to celebrate the new mission and ministry of Bishop Albert Bahhuth as he becomes the Regional Bishop for the San Fernando Region of the Archdiocese.







Catholic Q&A Topic: Disciples of all Nations

The St. James Mission Statement embraces the concept of *evangelization*. The Catholic Bishops say that evangelization happens, "when the word of Jesus speaks to people's hearts and minds."

Pope Francis, speaking in France this week, touched on evangelization in terms of inclusion and the universal dignity of all of God's people.

Bible scholarship describes an evangelistic individual who presented the word of Jesus to the early Church. This person was a Greek, a Gentile, a physician, and companion to St. Paul; a wonderfully literate writer of a gospel that is known as the gospel of the poor and of social justice. He is also attributed as author of The Acts of the Apostles.

Q: Who is this man that the Church honors, particularly on his October 18 Feast Day?

A: This man is St. Luke the Evangelist. His writings in holy scripture are beautifully written as he underscores the importance of women, of children, outcasts of different races and nationalities, the poor, the so-called "insignificant", the disreputable, the sinners and the Samaritans; all friends of Jesus. Luke wrote about the birth, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus. He is known for his "lost and found" stories: The Stray Sheep, The Missing Coin and The Wayward Son.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church #2600: "The Gospel according to St. Luke emphasizes the action of the Holy Spirit and the meaning of prayer in Christ's ministry..."

In his writings about the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies, St. Luke, in his first paragraph addresses his Gospel to Theophilus, which is translated as "friend of God" or "loved by God." Scholars tell us that Luke could have been writing his opening remarks in Luke to a specific person named Theophilus, or to a generic, broader audience. Either way, in the Gospels, Jesus continues to speak to people's hearts and minds. Father Thaddeus spoke at Mass about God's paradise as a place that welcomes everyone among its many mansions of glory. That universal, inclusionary, spirit of evangelization remains a mission to be put into practice.

Our St. James Choir sings a song of communion called "Taste And See"

"Taste and see, O, taste and see the goodness of God...who hears the cry of all in need."

This song is partly based on *Luke 1:52* wherein all hearts and minds are called to experience the word of Jesus as part of the essence of the spirit of evangelization.

Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

A life-long Catholic friend of mine recently mumbled to me, "I can't stand all these converts to the faith. They're always rocking the boat." It surprised me because he is dedicated to evangelization, and yet he struggles with openness to new Catholics. It made me realize how easily I close my heart to those whom I perceive to be outsiders who become new members of the Catholic community. Almost unconsciously I reduce the world to the categories of "us" and "them." The result is that meaningful community silently shrinks in my life. Don't we all do that to some degree?

This week Jesus' punchy parable about the two sons blows up that black and white world. One son said he wouldn't get to work, and then did. The other said he would, and then he did not. 'Which did the will of his father?" asks the Lord. Like so many of us, in identifying the first as the answer, the religious authorities manifest hidden hypocrisy in refusing to follow Jesus. They — like us — intuit the correct path but simply won't do it. The tax collectors and prostitutes are indeed following Jesus and thereby getting to work in the kingdom of God. *Everyone* is called to do God's will regardless of the labels we may apply to them.

This week let's reject the convenient but damaging categories of "insiders" and "outsiders." Instead, let's embrace a grateful attitude that Jesus is calling fallen, weak, and broken men and women like you and me. Then we begin to see that the tax collectors and prostitutes aren't *them*. They are *us*. And Jesus wants all of us working in his boat, no matter the rocking.

No sin is new to him.

No wrongdoing too great.


