Finance Council Presents Parish Annual Report

The Finance Council meets regularly throughout the year and oversees the finances of the general parish account as well as the School, Preschool and Gift Shop and advises Msgr. Meyers on issues regarding the temporal operations of the parish.

We first want to thank you for your past generosity to support St. James. It has been difficult these last several years in these Covid-affected times and we could not provide our ministries without you.

Today's bulletin contains the Financial Report for the past fiscal year ending June 30th, as well as results of the two previous years as comparison. You will notice that the parish suffered a loss in ordinary operations. The Restricted Income/Restricted Expenses categories are for donations that are restricted to those specific purposes. That money cannot be used for ordinary operations.

Our Ordinary Income, mostly from Sunday Collections for the past three years have remained relatively flat while expenses have increased significantly as more parish activities begin again. Inflation has caused an increase in almost every aspect of our lives. Just as your costs at home have increased, so have costs for the day to day operation of the parish.

We ask you to please consider increasing your regular contribution to the parish. If you haven't changed your offering for some time, please consider an increase to help with the rising costs of the parish. Thank you.



Catholic Q&A Topic: Disciples of all Nations

"My Angel shall go before thee..."

Long ago, Moses proceeded through a wilderness of hope on this promise and covenant that an angel of God would guide him and, as Psalm 103 says, "guard him in all of his ways."

This month's observance of the *Memorial of the Guardian Angels* elicits renewed thoughts about the place and the actions of Angels. And, while it's true that contemporary Catholics no longer face the direct hostilities of the Amorites, Hittites, Perizzites, Canaanites, Hivites, or Jebusites, as Moses faced, it is true that we face our own obstacles and bear our own crosses, and it is also true is that intercession by angelic influence remains a factor of faith.

The Catholic Church faithfully embraces, in angels, what St. Augustine described as their spirit, their nature and their office as messengers of God. From Gabriel at the Annunciation, to the singing of the choirs of angels in exaltation of the savior born, to the manifold intercession of God's messengers, the Church honors and values the actions of the angels. We also ponder Archangels such as Michael and Raphael, whose glory bore witness to the presence of God. Then there is the concept of heavenly hosts known as Guardian Angels.

Q: What does the *Catechism t*each about guardian angels?

A: Paragraph 334: "...the whole life of the Church benefits from the mysterious and powerful help of angels."

Paragraph 336 in the *Catechism* quotes St. Basil: "Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him to life."

The United States Conference of Bishops present a "Prayer to Your Guardian Angel":

"Angel of God, my guardian dear,
To whom God's love commits me here,
Ever this day be at my side,
To light and guard, to rule and guide.
Amen."

Finally, a portion of the Funeral Liturgy presents a coda:

"May the angels lead you into Paradise."

Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

Jesus' parables are much stranger than most people realize.

This week is an attention-getting example. He tells the religious leaders a parable about a completely absurd situation. Blood-thirsty and insane tenants violently abuse and kill the servants of their landlord. Inexplicably, the owner keeps sending them more victims of increasing value — up to and including his own son. Weird.

Usually, we hear this parable and assume it's an allegory: Jesus is the murdered son, the servants the prophets, etc. Fair enough. But notice — and here is where the weirdness deepens — Jesus seems to disagree with the Pharisees' interpretation that the landowner should and will punish the inheritance-obsessed murderers. So, is Jesus praising the psychotic and greedy murderers?! You can imagine the furrowed brows and deriding laughter as the scoffing crowd shuffles away.

If we stay with this tough parable, perhaps this truth emerges: God wants us to have an over-the-top obsession with a *totally undeserved inheritance*. Of course, we are forbidden to use violence. But the parable's violence gets our attention because it highlights the crazy goodness of the landowner. Jesus reveals that God is not merely in the business of rewarding the good and punishing the bad.

He is playing a much stranger game — one marked by a kind of over-the-top mercy, a breathtaking giving of what is *not* deserved. What would our week look like if we embraced this kind of desire for God's kingdom on earth, even if others think we're nuts?

This week let's seek God's kingdom with a passionate confidence in God's desire to give the good things we don't deserve.




