

Pastor's Christmas Letter

Dear Friends and Families of St. James.

This Christmas, I am offering you a letter of struggle, hope, joy and reconnection. The pandemic impacted so many of our lives. This is the story of two parishioners at Saint James who have allowed me to share their story with you. Their story is more powerful than anything I could say to you.

John and Barbara, husband and wife, were like many of us who watched Mass from home. They streamed it from their computer during the COVID isolation. Eventually, they stopped watching the Mass. When the church opened for Mass again, they continued to stay home to be "safe." Somehow, they just did not go back to church at all.

More recently they began sharing with each other how unhappy they were with their lives and even with the world. They were more critical of things, more angry, impatient, overwhelmed, and hopeless. They knew something was wrong, yet, at the time could not understand why. By now, they were completely disconnected from the church.

Then Barbara's mother became critically ill, and she was feeling very lost. Barbara knew she needed to pray for her mom. One Sunday, John and Barbara decided to go to the 10 am Mass.

They entered the church for the first time since the onset of the pandemic. As Barbara started to kneel and pray, she was overcome with a wave of emotions. She moved from feelings of guilt and disconnection to feelings of hope, joy, love, healing, wholeness and peace.

John was kneeling beside her dealing with his own wave of emotions. As he turned towards his wife with tears in their eyes, they both knew what had been missing. They had gone so long without the spiritual nourishment received from attending Mass in person and receiving the sacrament of the Eucharist. They had missed their church and the community of St. James. Now they go to church every Sunday and they are home.

Since being back they have also noticed that there are still many empty pews compared to pre-pandemic. They asked me to do something about it, because they know that many of those who have not returned must be experiencing the same kind of distress and restlessness as they had — until they found their way back again to their St. James Community, Jesus Christ, the Eucharist, faith, hope and love.

This Christmas as we all gather back 'home' together, our Christmas gift to you is Matthew Kelly's new book, *The Rocking Chair Prophet*. It tells a story of a man who reemerged from tragedy with uncommon wisdom. This book is a "rich exploration of life and the human condition. It is an invitation to rediscover yourself and reorient your life."

On behalf of our parish Clergy, I wish everyone a very merry Christmas, and a new year filled with joy and appreciation for God's love and blessings for the gift of our families and friends.

Topic: Spiritual Prophecy

In the light of seasonal gatherings, reconnecting to the church, and miraculous prophetic fulfillment, Monsignor Mike's pastoral direction draws our attention again to the spiritual writings of Matthew Kelly.



The parish generously gifts parishioners with Kelly's first novel, *The Rocking Chair Prophet.*

This book is described as "a transformational story about tragedy, uncommon wisdom, extraordinary gifts, and spiritual direction."

The Catholic Church and biblical scholar have much to contribute to a better understanding of the nature of the prophets:

- "Moses towers above all as the greatest prophet of the Old Testament; the herald of God's compassion."
- "We confess that the Holy Spirit spoke through the prophets."
- "Biblical prophets were not in the business of predicting the future but of saying something about the present."

"Prophet doesn't mean one who predicts what is to come but refers to the Greek word **prophetes**: one who speaks for another."

The Claretian Missionaries, through their publication *U.S. Catholic*, clarifies that the prophets

"brought and interpreted the word of God to a people who needed to be reminded of it.

Prophecy for Paul seemed to involve those who spoke with particular insight and wisdom about the things of God."

Mark Twain, in typically dry, laconic humor wrote:

"The art of prophecy is very difficult... especially with respect to the future."

From Church teachings, to spiritual novels, to popular literature, when it comes to the action of the Holy Spirit through the prophets we remain a people who continue to seek "insight and wisdom about the things of God."

Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

Life is troubling.

Who among us has not struggled with anxiety and difficulties, sometimes massive ones?

I certainly have, as have many of my loved ones. If we do, does this mean that we don't trust the Lord or just need to toughen up?

I don't think so. How encouraging for us anxious and troubled souls to hear Luke describe the Blessed Mother Mary in these words,

"But she was greatly troubled at what was said."

An archangel has visited her. An inconceivable promise has been made to her. Her life has become wildly unpredictable, perhaps more so than any person before or since.

The first point for us: the Lord is with her *precisely when she is troubled*. Her anxiousness and God's presence are not mutually exclusive. Christianity is not about a trance-like robotic indifference. It's about the presence of divine love.

Even in — especially in — troubled circumstances.

Our troubled soul can become our greatest treasure. What seems so troubling at first to Mary becomes the best possible thing, Jesus, the Savior and Lord, is now her son. All the difficulties and troubles remain, and yet her movement into the fullness of God is accelerated. What is troubling you right now? This scripture invites us now, this week, to hear the Lord's messenger say to us what he said to Mary,

"Do not be afraid! You have found favor with God."


