



Catholic Q & A

J.P. Alegria

Topic: A Clean Heart. O God.

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is the episcopal conference of the Catholic Church in the United States. They define their role:

"The U.S. Conference promotes the greater good which the Church offers humankind..."

The Bishops offer guidance for the Lenten Season.

Q: What is Lent?

A: "Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday; a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. The forty-day period of Jesus' trial in the desert echoes a number of events in the Old Testament. During Lent we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture. Also in Lent the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized."

In the spirit of mercy and faith that the Bishops highlight, Pope Benedict XVI wrote about Lent by referencing scripture from Hebrews Chapter 10:

"Let us be concerned with each other, to stir a response in love and good works."

The Pope pointed out that

"the appeal in this Letter to the Hebrews is particularly pressing in this holy season of preparation for Easter."

We experience the symbolic application of ashes. In the Old Testament,

"wearing ashes was a common sign of repentance for sins, and a sign of one's humility before God."

This year Lent begins on Ash Wednesday on Feb. 14th extending to March 28th and the familiar events of the feast of Maundy (or Holy) Thursday which commemorates the Institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper, the consecration of the holy oils, the reconciliation of penitents, and the Washing of the Feet.

The term Maundy marks our own role as disciples of Christ, because the word Maundy comes from the Latin *mandatum*, or *command*, which refers to the instructions Jesus gave his disciples at the Last Supper.

The faith-filled Lenten Season is truly emblematic of "the greater good which the Church offers humankind."

Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

Maybe I'm weird, but I like spending time in doctor's offices, confession lines in churches, auto repair shops, prison cells, and support groups of various kinds.

It's refreshing to be with people who humbly admit something is wrong and forthrightly set out on a path toward a solution. When we ignore what is off kilter, we become alone and fragile. In places where people are honest and hopeful about brokenness, sturdy if subtle fellowship usually ensues.

Consider the image we see of Jesus in the Gospel of Mark.

"...they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by a demon. The whole town was gathered at the door."

The entire human community is afflicted in various ways, and so it gradually forms a strange new community around Jesus. The healer from Nazareth is like a sun of health around which orbits a throng of humanity absorbing his healing rays. These blessed souls can't fix themselves and become healthy, and they know it. But they have found in him the living source of all imaginable healing.

It's the Church, isn't it? A sin-sick community gathered and healed is what happens at the beginning of every Mass. We shuffle in through the door from everywhere and announce that we are not okay, and we can't fix it. In doing so, we are drawn into the orbit of the healing power of Christ — and into a renewed community with the whole human family. It's nothing to fear or rush. Maybe we can even learn to enjoy more how good it is to be in such a happy place.


