

#### St. James Family Comes Home for Easter

The celebration of Holy Week at St. James touched our hearts as we saw the church filled several times as in pre-covid days, with so many new and familiar faces. Holy Week began with the Palm Sunday celebration of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem.

During the last 13 years over 1,600 people have carried the large palms for the blessing of palms. Within a few minutes we went from 'Hosanna to the son of David' to 'Crucify Him' as we read the story of Jesus' way of the cross.

On Holy Thursday during the Gospel of the Last Supper with the Apostles having their feet washed by Jesus, we washed the feet of parishioners and invited others in the congregation to become foot washers as well. Jesus reminded the apostles that they were not being called to leadership, but rather to service to others in sharing the gospel message. Since the beginning of Covid it was one of the first times as a whole church that we have been able to share from the chalice the Blood of Christ.







On **Good Friday** after the reading of the Passion of Christ we shared in the Veneration of the Cross with each person in the church coming forward to reverence the cross. It was an emotional time for many as they acknowledged that Jesus died for our sins.

On Holy Saturday as we celebrated the Easter Vigil we moved from lighting the Easter Candle recalling that Christ is the Light of our lives to reading key Old Testament verses of God's hand in leading up to the saving work of Christ in the world. The celebration continued with adult baptisms, our own renewal of our baptismal promises and our trust in God's saving grace for our lives.

Holy Week truly was more than just a lot of ritual, it's a welcoming home of our St. James Family. Alleluia.





#### **Topic: New Life**

The salvific, miraculous events of Easter bestow gifts of inestimable value to the faithful.

**Q:** What does Pope Francis proclaim about the essential nature of some of these compelling gifts?

A: The Holy Father wrote:

"Forgiveness in the Holy Spirit is the Easter gift that enables our interior resurrection."

Confession is the sacrament of resurrection, pure mercy. He urged all those who hear confessions to convey the "sweetness of mercy." All those who hear include our St. James' priests for whom we give thanks.

Saint Faustina Kowalska of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, in her diary for day 2 of the Divine Mercy Novena writes about mercy and the role of priests and religious:

"Today bring to me the Souls of Priests and Religious, and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy... through them...my mercy flows out upon mankind... they guide others in the way of salvation."

The Pope, in a homily on a past Divine Mercy Sunday said:

#### Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

A protestant pastor friend of mine was invited to meet Pope Francis with a group of other pastors. He noticed the Pope's chair was especially ornate and set at the head of the group. He somewhat playfully said, "Holy Father, why do *you* get that special chair?" The group chuckled nervously at my friend's audacious chide.

The following year, the group was invited to return. They entered the room to find only simple chairs placed in a circle. Pope Francis entered, sat down in one of the humble chairs and, looking directly at my friend, with a twinkle in his eye, asked, "What do you think of my chair now?" My friend was stunned that the Pope remembered his concerns — and took the time to answer them.

Thomas the apostle was certainly stunned by the Risen Jesus displaying his wounds in person. But he also must have been equally shocked that Jesus knew and answered his particular questions, worries, and even demands related to his faith. How humbled — and perhaps a bit terrified — he must have been to realize God remembers his concerns and cares enough to answer them.

What questions or demands about Jesus do you find in your heart? Like Thomas, will you be bold enough to voice them this week? How wonderful to know that if we do so, God will remember and respond even to our most


