Pastor's Letter

Dear Friends and Families of St. James,

The Building Fund is an important part of the maintenance and development of our parish facilities.

For many years our school has struggled with a shortage of electricity with the added use of technology, chrome books and computers—with each classroom having only one outlet. Last spring we discovered that the main gas line into the school had a number of underground leaks and gas was shut off, shutting down the heaters in the classrooms.

We elected to forgo the gas line replacement and instead have brought additional power lines from the O'Gorman Center to new subpanels in the school. This has enabled us to replace the gas heaters with electric heater/air cooler units and add additional electrical outlets to each classroom. The work was just completed over the Easter break. The cost of the project was \$215,000.

As you know, the new play structure was installed during the Christmas break a few months ago. The cost of the project, \$225,000.

We have just submitted our plans to the City of Torrance to remodel a portion of the O'Gorman Center into a new 2-classroom Preschool. We expect that the permitting for construction can be completed sometime during the summer and construction to begin at that time.

The cost of the project has not yet been determined, but it will most likely come in at \$400,000 to 500,000. While costly, moving the Preschool to the school makes both programs work together much more efficiently and removing the Preschool from the Community Campus project is a first-phase major benefit for the design of the property.

These three projects, costing about \$1 million greatly improve the school and parish ministries, but leave us in financial need.





Catholic Q & A

J.P. Alegria

Topic: Credo, Creed, Believe

The literature that chronicles the saints includes a boy named Isidore. He was born in the latter half of the 6th century in Spain. Isidore, it is said, was born into a family of saints. His brothers served the Church, one as a Bishop, the other as Archbishop. His sister was a nun, and all three of his siblings were canonized. For Isidore's part, his own poor results in his studies frustrated him to the point that he ran away from home.

Reaching a stream along his desperate road he observed a stone hollowed out by dripping water. That image of elemental persistence struck an inner chord that seems to have engendered a renewing sense of application and perseverance, setting the boy on a course of unwavering determination; these character traits present in so many saints. St. Isidore went on to flourish. He became an illustrious Archbishop and a Doctor of the Church.

Q: What does the Church teach about the lives of the Saints and their place in our faith?

A: The catechism, the liturgy, and spiritual biographical writings mark the single-minded dedication of the saints, who often faced monumental personal challenges on their particular road to holiness.

Consider that at each Mass we embrace the words of the Apostle's Creed. The Latin word "Credo" translates as I believe. "I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic church, the communion of saints..."


St. Isidore was declared a Doctor of the Church. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops reports that many do not appreciate the nature and placement of these Doctors. The USCCB marks them as saints who are elevated by Papal declaration in light of their theological actions and doctrinal writings. These saints are advanced in status because of "...the knowledge of our faith and the cause of Christ and his Church."

The title of Doctor was first given in the Middle Ages. The original four: St. Ambrose, St. Augustine, St. Gregory the Great, and St, Jerome. There are now 37 Doctors of the Church including four women added after 1970: St. Teresa of Avila, St. Catherine of Siena, St. Therese of Lisieux, and St. Hildegard.

Young Isidore serves as but one example among the communion of saints as an extraordinary exemplar of faith. As the Catechism says: "Saints; see holiness." Credo...I believe.

I will also uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Is. 41:10

'Do not fear, for I am with you: Do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will also help you,



Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

When I was a kid, a friend at my home parish told me, "If you get to Mass by the Gospel reading, it counts!"

As a lifelong late-arriver, it's something I have told myself many times, especially in my earlier years as a Catholic. If the "it counts" is justifiable on a pathetically minimal scale of liturgical legalism, then the Gospel reading today shows how insanely wrong-headed it is. and how helpful it is to re-think the Mass in its light.

The famous "Road to Emmaus" story recounts, on that first Sunday of the Resurrection, the basic two-fold structure of the Mass: Word, followed by Eucharist. Jesus spends a significant period of time with two dismayed disciples, as he connects a wide swath of the Hebrew scriptures with his own suffering, death, and resurrection. They would later report that this Liturgy of the Word touched their hearts with an inexplicable fire. This Word-induced flame alone is what leads the two disciples to discover Jesus' presence in the "breaking of the bread."

With this in mind, how can we possibly think that the Lituray of the Word is unnecessary or incidental? The two disciples needed the Scriptures explained to them in order to experience Jesus alive in the eucharistic breaking of bread. Sure, we say, but they had the Risen Jesus. But that's precisely the point: Jesus is risen and accompanies us in both parts of the Mass. Imagine how much our experience of Jesus in the Eucharist would deepen if we (preachers and listeners) took even more seriously that Jesus himself sets our hearts ablaze with his Word so that we know him in the Eucharist. That Word-induced fire counts, too!




