## Topic: Guide and Guardian of the Church

**Q:** How often do we pray for the Church and for the Pope?



**A:** Often. Here at St. James we regularly offer prayers of petition during the Mass for our Church and for the Holy Father. But this particular question was asked by Rev. Alban Butler as part of his portrait of Saint Catherine of Siena. Her feast day is celebrated on Monday of the 5<sup>th</sup> week of Eastertide this year, April 29<sup>th</sup>.

Butler gives particular emphasis that Saint Catherine was all about prayer and heroically relentless action in the name of the Church and the Pope during the challenging 14<sup>th</sup> century when the Church and the Pope were threatened by formidable heresy amid the chaos of a serious schism, with an anti-pope and a whole lot of strife.

The Church honors St. Catherine, whose remarkable virtue, spiritual doctrine and ecclesial advocacy elevated her as a Doctor of the Church:

- She counseled Pope Gregory XI to reform the clergy and the Papal States.
- She was an ambassador of peace and harmony between cities, and recognized as Europe's Patron Saint.
- She advocated for the rights of the papacy and the renewal of religious life.
- Her emblem is a white lily representing her purity.
- Her writings and prayers have special authority, infused with "sound doctrine and spiritual inspiration."
- In a vision, Christ offered her a crown of gold, and one of thorns. Catherine chose the latter.
- She is known as the "*seraphic* saint," her sometimes mystical ways resembling *angelic* qualities.

St. Catherine had a nickname, "Euphrosyne," which is Greek for *Joy*.

May we be lights of prayerful joy and relentless action for our Church.

'Do not fear, for I am with you;  
Do not be afraid, for I am your God.  
I will strengthen you,  
I will also help you,  
I will also uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Is. 41:10



Recently I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert.

I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me, Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know him and his willingness to die for us! This week he says, "**I know my own and my own know me,**" and "**I lay down my life for the sheep.**" Here we encounter an insanely excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down his life for you and me — and he has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and his saving love. This Easter season, the risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about his love. He never ceases to lay down his life for us.

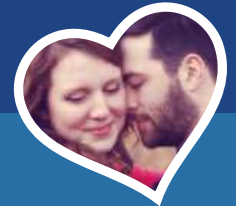

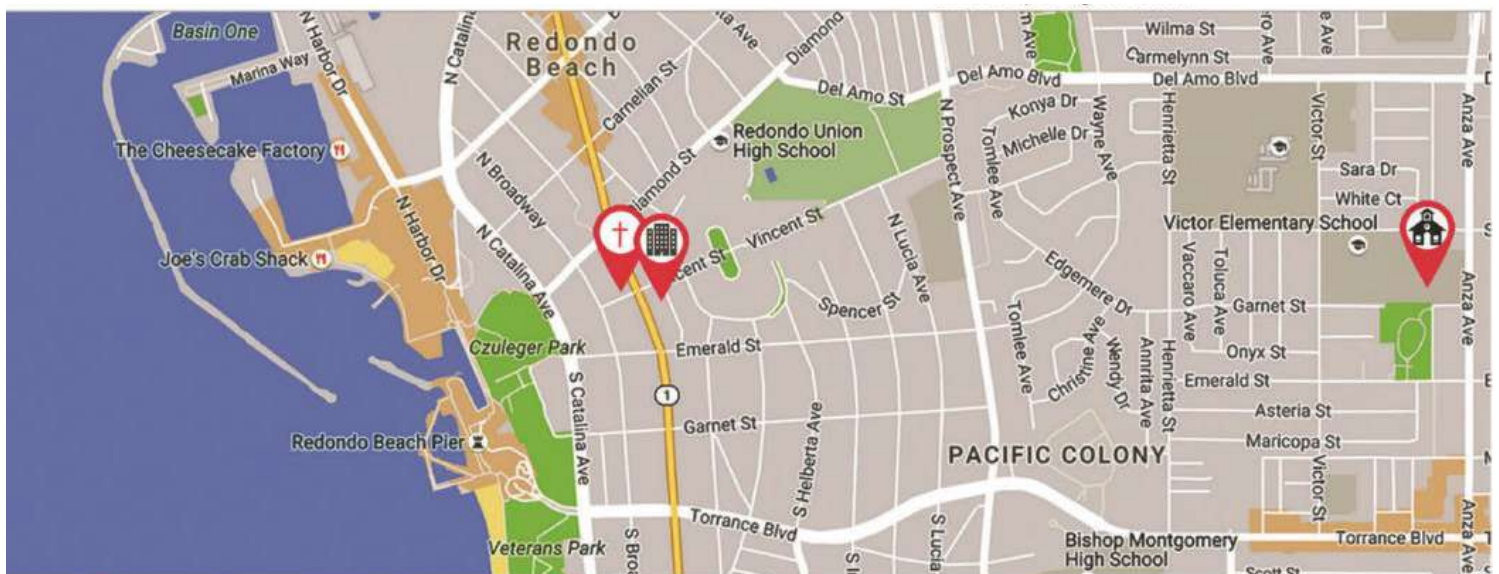
