# The Last Supper and Holy Communion

Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying,


"This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me."

And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you" (Luke 22:19-20)

In the Last Supper of Christ and His disciples, Jesus offers bread and wine as His body and blood for his followers to partake "in remembrance" of Him.

The Council of Trent declared:

"Because Christ our Redeemer said that it was truly his body that he was offering under the species of bread, it has always been the conviction of the Church of God, and this holy Council now declares again, that by the consecration of the bread and wine there takes place a change of the whole substance of the bread into the substance of the body of Christ our Lord and of the whole substance of the wine into the substance of his blood. This change the holy Catholic Church has fittingly and properly called transubstantiation." (CCC 1376)



### Catholic Q & A

## Topic: Words of Life

In Luke's Gospel we find Zacchaeus, a Jewish man intrigued by the phenomenal, burgeoning ministry of Jesus. Scripture relates that, with a determined spirit, he was of one mind: "I want to see him!" Small in stature, the affluent tax collector and seeker climbed a sycamore tree for greater perspective. Jesus recognized him, calling him out by name; and a spiritual connection followed.

**Q:** Could that encounter, illustrative of a person seeking Jesus, be a metaphor for finding and living the Good News, and doesn't it reflect a connective thread of active, dynamic faith in action here at St. James?

**A:** Yes. Firstly, Pope John Paul II told his Bishops in 1988: "When we preach the liberating message of Jesus we are offering the words of life to the world." The USCCB wrote:

"We believe that the Gospel of Jesus is a Gospel of Life."

Here at St. James our pastoral leaders echo those spiritual directives that promote a real *Living* Word:

\*Monsignor Mike, back when he gifted us the Kelly book, *Holy Moments*, wrote about

"...finding hope, strength and love in the Word of Christ that we share each time we gather."

\*At a recent weekday Mass, Father Thaddeus spoke in his homily about, "...looking for and consulting Jesus in all things, at all times." As far as the liturgy goes, Father preaches, "Put into practice what you believe."

\*In a Sunday homily, Father Chibuike spoke about "inner disposition." He called on parishioners to,

"Live your faith. Live what you believe."

\*Deacon Bob often calls on the faithful as they go forth after Mass, to not only seek, hear and venerate the Word at Sunday Mass, but to engage with it always, and put it into practice:


"Love and serve the Lord, by loving and serving one another."

\*Finally, our patron, St. James, on God's Good News:

"Be doers of the word, and not hearers only..."

By God's grace, faith, word, and deed...we want to see Him.

'Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will also help you,



I will also uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Is. 41:10

### Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

My friend and fellow pastor, Father Paul, noticed unsightly, overgrown trees near his parish church.

He asked the maintenance crew to cut back the growth, which they happily did, telling him the trees would be much healthier and even fuller after a good pruning. A few days later, Father Paul received a letter from an irate man in the neighborhood who wrote, "Jesus would never prune trees like that. He loves trees, unlike you."

I suspect that the neighbor was not familiar with this week's Gospel in which Jesus says of his Father,

"He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit" (John 15:2)

I don't mean to pick too much on that fellow. He was perhaps ignorant of arboriculture. But I'd wager his main confusion was the pruning and removing quality of God's love. That confusion afflicts us all to some degree, doesn't it? It is just so darn easy to react negatively when God cuts something out of our lives and assume it's not his work at all. In the moment, all we see is the loss, and not the loving desire for future flourishing.

The cross is the great pruning of Christ's body. Jesus' rising is the brand-new growth. It is God's promise to us that all the painful pruning in life is leading us somewhere beautiful. What has been cut back or out in your life? A friend, an opportunity, a sense of certainty, a job, health, a relationship? This week, offer those dry branches to the one who lovingly prunes us in order to make our lives burst with verdant growth.
