Pastor's Letter

Dear Friends and Families of St. James,

Our New Pastor is Fr. Matt Murphy

I am pleased to announce that Fr. Matt Murphy will be joining our St. James family as pastor on July 1st.

Fr. Matt was born in Pennsylvania in 1965 but spent most of his life in Southern California where his home parishes were St. Didacus, Sylmar and St. Kateri Tekakwitha, Santa Clarita.

His first career was in the grocery industry working for almost 30 years for companies such as Safeway Stores, Weber's Bread, and Snapple Beverage Company.

While in his mid-30s God caught his attention and he returned to the Catholic Church

after a 20-year absence. A year later, Fr. Matt was serving his parish as a youth minister, and a brief time later he began to discern a call to the priesthood.

He entered St. John Seminary, Camarillo, in September 2009 and was ordained a priest on June 4, 2016.

Following an initial 2-year assignment at St. Monica's, Santa Monica, Fr. Matt was sent to Malibu to Our Lady of Malibu Church as Administrator and was appointed as pastor of the parish in July 2020.

Fr. Matt looks forward to building a vibrant community at St. James that will shine Christ's light throughout Redondo Beach and the surrounding areas.

He'll be meeting with the Pastoral Council, Finance Council and Office Staff in the coming weeks.

We look forward to welcoming him to St. James as he makes his move here to the South Bay.





Catholic Q & A

J.P. Alegria

Topic: Catholicity

The Saint James choir sings a song about "spiritual connection," proclaiming:

"I am the vine, you are the branches..."

Those words from the text of John 15 were a focus in a recent Sunday, (First Communion,) Mass. Here Jesus teaches that we must *remain* in Him:

"By this my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples."

To that end we profess the belief outlined within the Nicene Creed:

"I believe in one holy, Catholic, and apostolic Church."

The fourth century Byzantine -days confab which articulated that creed was convened by Constantine and attended by more than 300 Bishops in Nicaea, an ancient Greek walled town, (present day Iznik, Turkey.)

Speaking of spiritual connectivity, among the early vines and branches were the Apostles, originally chosen by Jesus to teach and spread his Word.

Q: What are just some of the qualities of faith discernable among four of these Apostles as described in the accounts of their lives?

A: Matthew, the publican tax collector, answered the call of Jesus, going from sinner to penance.

"He wrote his Gospel to teach his countrymen that Jesus was their true Lord and King."

Mark, known as the "Evangelist," wrote about the teachings of Jesus and those of St. Paul. In Alexandria, Egypt, in true apostolic fashion, Mark set up the first Christian school. This apostle is admired for his eloquence and faithful interpretation of even the gestures, words and looks of Jesus.

Luke, though not an eyewitness of the life of Jesus, contributes as "the historian of the New Testament." His Acts of the Apostles is a sequel to his Gospel. He died a martyr's death.

John was the youngest of the apostles, and is also known as "the Evangelist." This apostle was present at the Agony, the Transfiguration, the Last Supper, and with Mary at the foot of the Cross. He wrote his Gospel and later, on the isle of Patmos, described heavenly visions of the Apocalypse.

These apostles taught and spread the Word. Reverend Alban Butler, in his *Lives of the Saints* reflects the theme of vine and branches regarding our own role as disciples:

"Christ has given all He had for thee; do thou give all thou hast for Him?"

Each of us, following the apostolic tradition, are disciples, capable of bearing much fruit.

Gospel Meditation— Father John Muir

Once a man came to the Vatican and asked to see Pope John Paul II, claiming that they had been friends in Poland.

When told of the man, the Pope said,

"He is mistaken about our friendship.

I don't recall ever having suffered with him."

As it turned out, the man had never known the Pope.

Now, I'm not sure if the story is totally factual. But doesn't the juxtaposition of *suffering* with *friendship* sound exactly like JPII?

He understood that the deepest and most lasting friendships are forged in the fires of shared suffering. No suffering, no friendship. Amazing.

This week we hear Jesus say to the apostles and to us,

"You are my friends if you do what I command you" (John 15:14).

In Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, God entered the world of human suffering and transformed it into an avenue of friendship with Himself. Following His command — to love, to lay down our lives for others — will always entail suffering. But this suffering only deepens our friendship with Him. His suffering is ours; ours is His. We have become friends of God.

This week, how might you share your suffering with the Risen Jesus?

How might he be sharing his suffering with you, in the lives of those around you? Be attentive to that, and you'll find that you are indeed a friend of God, because you've suffered together a great deal.






