PASTOR'S CORNER

Hello beautiful children of God!

Holy Week is the most sacred time of the year for Christians, where we enter into the heart of what it means to be a follower of Jesus. It begins with Palm Sunday, which marks Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. People laid down palm branches, shouting "Hosanna!"—they were excited, filled with hope, expecting a political savior. But what they didn't realize was that the kind of King Jesus was going to be wasn't the kind they were expecting. He came to conquer hearts, not just kingdoms.

From there, we move into the most intense and powerful days of the Sacred Triduum-Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday.

Holy Thursday is the celebration of the Last Supper. Here, Jesus institutes the Eucharist, the gift of Himself to us. He takes bread and says, "This is my Body," and wine, "This is my Blood." He gives us this sacrament to sustain us, to remind us that He is always with us, even when we're facing our darkest moments. And, in washing His disciples' feet. He shows us that true greatness is found in humility and service.

Then, Good Friday. It's the day we remember the Passion of Christ, His suffering and death on the cross. The cross is the greatest symbol of God's love—His total and utter self-giving. We are reminded that Jesus didn't just die for humanity in general; He died for you. The cross shows us how far He is willing to go to bring us back to the Father.

Holy Saturday is the day of waiting—silent, expectant, in the tomb. It's a day of contemplation, where we sit in the mystery of Jesus' death, wondering and trusting that something good is coming.

Finally, we reach Easter Sunday, the day of Resurrection. Jesus is risen! Death has been conquered! Holy Week culminates in this victory, and it's the moment we see that death is not the end. The resurrection shows us that, with God, there is always hope, always new life. That's the Good News we celebrate in Holy Week.

I pray that you are able to join us for the Holy Week liturgies so we can celebrate the Paschal Mystery, Jesus' passion, death, and Resurrection, as a community. Please refer to our bulletin or website for our Holy Week schedule.

SEE THE POWER OF GOD

By way of his writings, and by virtue of his words of catechesis, we may "ask" Pope Francis about Easter:

Q: Your Holiness, you've said that Easter is a promise. In what way is it a promise?

A: "Easter is a promise that no matter how dark the world may seem and no matter how heavy the burdens one carries, victory belongs to the Risen Christ, and all who believe in him."

Q: As we lift our eyes to the risen Lord, what may we ask?

A: "Let us ...ask that the power of his resurrection may roll away the heavy stones that weigh down our souls."

Q: As "Servant of the Servants of God," how do you view Easter?

A: Easter is "the most important and beautiful day of history, the day Christ rose from the dead...the Lord has built us a bridge to life...Easter marks the rebirth of hope amid the ruins of failure. Only the risen Christ, by granting us the forgiveness of our sins, opens the way for a renewed world...everything begins anew!"

Q: Finally Most Holy Father, in the proclamation of Easter, the venerable song of the Exsultet calls on the hosts of heaven and the Angel ministers of God to be jubilant amid the sound of the trumpet of salvation that announces our mighty King's triumph. What is one of the most precious gifts found within this proclamation?

A: "On this day when we celebrate the life given us in the resurrection of the Son, let us remember the infinite love of God for each of us; a love that overcomes every limit and every weakness."


