PASTOR'S CORNER

Statement on the Death of the Holy Father Pope Francis

Most Reverend José H. Gomez Archbishop of Los Angeles

April 21, 2025

I join the family of God here in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, and Catholics all over the world, in grieving the loss of our Holy Father.

In this beautiful Easter season, when we celebrate our hope in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, we pray that the angels may lead Pope Francis into paradise, that the saints and martyrs welcome him, and that God in his mercy will make his face shine upon his faithful servant and grant him eternal rest in the love that never ends.

There will be more to say in the days ahead, but in this moment I find myself reflecting with gratitude on the Holy Father's many kindnesses and expressions of pastoral care for us here in Los Angeles.

Over the years, he appointed seven auxiliary bishops to assist me in serving the family of God and he was always quick to show his spiritual closeness to us in our times of need. It was just in January that he offered prayers and words of consolation as we faced the destruction caused by the wildfires in the Palisades and Altadena. I will never forget his fraternal comfort as we mourned the sudden taking of our beloved Bishop David O'Connell in 2023.

In this time of mourning, my prayer is that all of us in the Church will honor Pope Francis' legacy by remembering that he called us to urgent tasks that are still not finished:

We must continue our work of serving the poor, the migrant, and all who are forgotten on society's "peripheries."

We must persevere in caring for our common home, which is the earth, and in building a world that respects the sanctity and dignity of all human life and the Creator's desire that we live in peace and fraternity as one human family.

And we must evangelize, spreading the joy of the Gospel as missionary disciples, accompanying our brothers and sisters and helping them to find in Jesus the happiness and love that every human heart longs for.


Above all, we must deepen our own love for Jesus and our commitment to seeking his holiness and reflecting his mercy and love in our daily lives.

Pope Francis showed us, by his constant example, that we should have a great devotion to the Virgin Mary, who is our Blessed Mother and the Mother of the Church.

We turn to Holy Mary now, and we ask for her protection and tender care. May she wrap our Holy Father in the mantle of her love. And may he rest in peace.



Gardens of Healing for survivor-victims in all five of the Archdiocese's pastoral regions

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles has created gardens of healing in each of the Archdiocese's pastoral regions, dedicated to those harmed by sexual abuse, in their family, church or community. Located at St. Camillus Pastoral Center in Boyle Heights (San Gabriel Pastoral Region), Our Lady of the Assumption Parish in Ventura (Santa Barbara Pastoral Region), St. Francis de Sales Parish in Sherman Oaks (San Fernando Pastoral Region), St. Bernadette Parish in Los Angeles (Our Lady of the Angels Pastoral Region), and Our Lady of Refuge in Long Beach (San Pedro Pastoral Region) these gardens offer a sacred space for all those impacted by abuse to seek comfort and solace. In each garden there is a weeping wall and a plaque with a reflection by Archbishop Gomez, which starts with: "Dedicated to all those impacted by sexual abuse in the Church, their communities, their families - may all who visit find some measure of renewal, peace and comfort in doing so." VICTORY AND KINSHIP

Back in the mid-twentieth century, CBS Radio, (then later CBS Television,) presented a dramatic series of educational shows that depicted a variety of major historical, world-changing events. The series was called "You Are There." The host, newsman Walter Cronkite, set the opening scene of each event, drawing the listener/viewer in as a sort of witness to history with the words,"...and you are there!"

The Catholic Church teaches that the Easter Triduum forms the summit of our liturgy; "...a celebration of Jesus's victory; God's greatest act of love to redeem mankind." Major, world-changing event, indeed.

Q: As to these historically indisputable, authentically concrete and mysterious holy days, what if we were there?

A: Scholars talk about those long-ago chief witnesses among the crowds who were there: Mary, the mother of Jesus, Mary Magdalene, Mary of Clopas, the Apostle John, Veronica, Simon of Cyrene, the Roman soldiers, the two criminals, the chief priests, scribes, and elders, Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus.

Our Church's Magisterium, sacred tradition, clergy, catechism and liturgy guide us as witnesses today to the events that gave us a savior. The shining light of trinitarian love illuminates our faith in that we are here with the living God in our midst.

Like the two disciples on that long ago dusty road to the village of Emmaus, our eyes are opened to the scriptures in our hearts and in our minds by the Church and its teachings. Holy scripture gives us the Paschal Mystery, and we are there and here, as disciples of faith.

Pope St. John Paul II in 1986 said it well about "being there" with Easter:

"We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song!"




