PASTOR'S CORNER

Hello beautiful children of God!

In **John 21:1-19**, we encounter a moment of profound mercy and mission. The disciples are back in Galilee, back where it all began. Peter says, "I'm going fishing," not just out of boredom, but perhaps confusion—maybe even discouragement. After denying Jesus three times, Peter likely felt disqualified. So, he returns to what he knows.

But then Jesus shows up—on the shore, at dawn, just as He did when He first called them. He tells them to cast their nets, and again, the nets are filled. It's a moment of divine déjà vu, and John gets it: "It is the Lord!"

Now, the charcoal fire is key. The only other charcoal fire in John's Gospel is where Peter denied Jesus. Now, at another fire, Jesus invites Peter into healing—not by shaming him, but by restoring him. Three times He asks, "Do you love me?" Three denials. Three chances to respond in love.

But notice this: Jesus doesn't just restore Peter. He recommissions him. "Feed my lambs. Tend my sheep." Jesus entrusts His flock to a broken, forgiven man. That's grace. And that's our call too.

God doesn't wait for perfect people. He calls those willing to return to the shore, admit their weakness, and say, "Yes, Lord, I love You."

If you've failed, don't stay in the boat. Don't go back to the "old life." Jesus is standing on the shore of your heart, asking, "Do you love Me?" If your answer is yes—even with trembling lips—He says, "Then follow Me."

He has a mission for you.



TUESDAY BIBLE STUDY





GOD'S PLAN

Amid the passing of Pope Francis, it seems fitting that we explore Father Sebastian's book which Pastor Matt gifted us, Heart Of The Gospel, wherein we read about "the spiritual character of the Messianic Kingdom in simple, beautifully accessible biblical poetry." Francis seemed to echo these themes in practice. That holy lexicon, embedded with terms such as: humility, mercy, sincerity, and compassion, is where we find the defining goods and ideals of the beatitudes, namely: faith, love and happiness.

In this Jubilee Year of Hope we turn attention to Vatican City, its Apostolic Palace and Sistine Chapel. In that setting of Renaissance masterpieces of painting and sculpture by Michelangelo, Botticelli, Raphael and multiple other artists we find 136 Cardinals gathered for mourning, then the general congregations that culminate in conclave and the white smoke of papal succession.

Q: What, briefly and in general terms, can be said about a Pope's legacy, the future of nearly 1.4 billion Catholics around the world, and the Beatitudes at this inflection point in history?

A: We watch and pray for a fruitful outcome of the conclave, which Pope John Paul II called "a duty to elect, by apostolic norms, the Successor of Peter.....Servant of the Servants of God."

We appreciate the Jesuit Pope Francis, "the People's Pope with "the heart of a pastor," and his humble yet powerful advocacy in leadership. Historian Jon Meachum said that the Pope's "tonal and theological shifts mark the best of the noblest parts of the Gospels." Cardinal Dolan of New York points out that Jesus, despite the crowds described in the Gospels, always seemed to recognize those on the margins such as the woman with the chronic illness, or the man on the side of the road who called out to the son of David. Similarly, Cardinal Dolan called Pope Francis's own eye on the marginal as a "radar" of sorts; his humility, compassion and love, a "hug" for everyone.

Love. The heart of the Gospel. Biblical poetry of accessibility. Beatitudes of happiness, put into practice.






