#### PASTOR'S CORNER

#### Hello beautiful children of God!

Pope Leo XIV came out swinging in his first homily on May 9, laying down a bold challenge to every baptized believer: wake up, reclaim your faith, and live like Jesus actually matters. With the passion of a shepherd who's seen the battlefield, he called out the spiritual apathy of our age-not with condemnation, but with a father's urgency and love.

Speaking to a world caught in the grip of comfort, success, and digital distractions, Pope Leo reminded us that none of that stuff saves us. He wasn't subtle: too many Christians are living like atheists, and even among the baptized, Christ has become a footnote instead of the cornerstone. It's time to stop treating our faith like a cultural accessory and start living it like the life-or-death reality that it is.

What really fired up the homily was his missionary heart. Drawing from his time serving in the slums of Peru, Pope Leo made it clear that the Church's mission is not to entertain, blend in, or play it safe. It's to evangelize. To be holy. To bring hope where there is none. That means being joyful, courageous, and totally in love with Jesus.

Bottom line? Pope Leo XIV is lighting a fire under the Church. He's telling us to rise, be saints, and be a light in the chaos. This isn't about nostalgia or fear-it's about rediscovering the radical joy and power of the Gospel. And it starts now, with you.

I encourage each of you to read the May 9 homily to inspire you to a life of holiness.



#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

#### Age-appropriate curiosity in young children

Knowing the difference between age-appropriate and inappropriate behaviors in children can help safe adults determine whether something feels "off" about a child's behavior and could indicate potential sexual abuse. For preschool children and young children (around ages 4-6), exploring their bodies is natural. They are not yet old enough to understand the idea of "private" naturally, and may also be curious about others' bodies - parents, friends, etc. These behaviors are common and developmentally appropriate for their age and stage. 

#### BLESSINGS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Part of the conclave experience included the physical setting of Vatican City with its dazzling array of sights, sounds and sacred tradition. The countless artistic masterpieces abound amid the buildings of Roman, Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, and Neoclassical styles. A culminating physical feature is the inscription in Latin, high on the facade of the Basilica, which translates in part: "In honor of the Prince of Apostles..." Beneath that inscription is the Papal Balcony called "The Loggia of the Blessings." Pope Leo XIV stepped onto that balcony and as a successor of Peter, invoked the blessing of the newly-risen Christ:

"Peace be with you all!"

That particular visual and his early remarks about the Church and a loving God along with his personal motto could provide a bit of insight in terms of his own "style."

**Q:** Each pope chooses a papal motto, a spiritual outlook to live by and to feature on their papal coat of arms. What is the new Pope's motto?

**A:** The new Pope's motto goes a long way in answering questions about his potential methodology:

"In illo uno unum." "In the one Christ we are one."

Cardinal Prevost wrote: "As can be seen from my episcopal motto, unity and communion are truly part of the charism of the order of Saint Augustine, and also my way of acting and thinking."

Pope Leo is known for a church that operates in the spirit of synod, which essentially means inclusionary dialogue, listening, and discerning action. Pastor Matt also spoke in homily about evangelization and the path to the sheepfold that is the welcoming, universal Church.




