PASTOR'S CORNER

Hello beautiful children of God!

Today we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**, the central mystery of our faith, not merely a doctrine to be understood, but a truth to be adored. The Trinity is not an abstract puzzle for theologians to unravel, but the very identity of God: One Divine Nature in Three Divine Persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

This mystery is not peripheral, it is foundational. Every sign of the cross we make, every prayer we offer, every sacrament we receive is Trinitarian. God has revealed Himself not as a solitary monad, but as a communion of Persons - a perfect unity of love.

The Father eternally begets the Son; the Son is eternally begotten, not made; and the Holy Spirit proceeds from the love between them. We are not merely told *that* God is love (1 John 4:8), but shown *how* He is love: not in isolation, but in the eternal giving and receiving among the Divine Persons.

What does this mean for us? Made in the image of this Trinitarian God, we are called to communion. Isolation is not our destiny, relationship is. The unity of the Trinity is not uniformity, but harmony among distinction. So too in the Church, we are many members but one Body (1 Cor 12:12).

In an age that exalts individualism, the Trinity calls us back to holy communion, with God and with one another. Let us not be content to merely "believe" in the Trinity. Let us adore, and in adoring, be drawn into the divine life offered to us through Christ.

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor 13:13) be with us always.

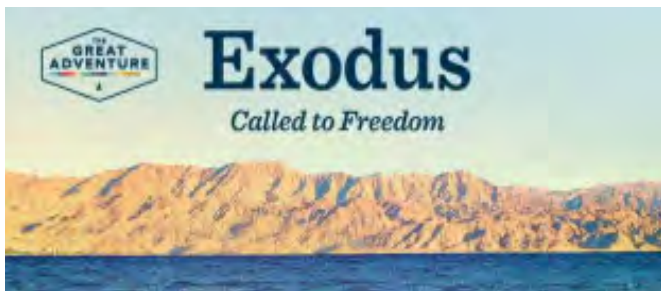

DID YOU KNOW?

Body safety information for young children

Children should know the difference between “okay” and “not okay” or “good” and “bad” touches — touches that are welcome and comforting, and those that are intrusive, unwanted, painful, or uncomfortable. Children should know that they have the right to say “no” to being touched, even to adults, and that no children or adults should touch their private parts unless in very specific circumstances, and for a healthy purpose. This is where it can be helpful to discuss “safe adults,” like doctors, who check our bodies to help keep us healthy, and only in the presence of a parent or trusted adult. CATHOLIC Q & A

J.P. ALEGRIA

LYRICS, MUSIC, LITURGY

In the St. James Choir song book there is a section entitled Petition & Prayer which features a familiar song called To You O God, I Lift Up My Soul.

As part of our ecclesial worship we sing and identify in heart-felt ways with the music of the Church. This particular song is representative of just one example of the value and beauty of the music of faith.

Q: A musical refrain can be defined as a device of composition that contains and repeats the main idea or message of a song. What do we find in this musical petition, this Catholic refrain, repeated as a prayer of faith?

A: We find a measure of saving grace: "*To you, O God, I lift up my soul, lift up my spirit to my Lord...*"

The Catechism says: "*The musical tradition of the universal Church is a treasure of immeasurable value...*"

In Ephesians we find: Address one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs singing and making melody to the Lord with all your heart." We're familiar with St. Augustine's aphorism: "He who sings prays twice." He also wrote: "...deeply moved by your hymns and voices through your Church; sounds distilling the truth in my heart."

The Catechism teaches about music's place in the Mass and the "cultural richness" of its harmonious action."

Addressing one another, we continue to sing the truth in our hearts; To you, O God.

It is fitting therefore that the Saint James Choir harmonizes from a songbook with the title: Choral Praise.
