# PASTOR'S CORNER

**Hello beautiful children of God!**

On this radiant solemnity of **Corpus Christi**, the Church pauses to adore what She dares to receive every day: the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Today, the veil is lifted a little further, and we are invited not just to believe, but to behold, to process publicly with the Eucharist, proclaiming to the world: God is with us, and He is not hidden.

The Lord, in His astounding humility, gives us not a mere sign or reminder, but **Himself**. As He said plainly at the Last Supper, "This is My Body... This is My Blood" (Matt 26:26-28). These are not symbolic gestures. This is the very mystery of our redemption, offered anew on every altar and resting now in every tabernacle.

How startling it is: the Creator of the stars made Himself food for the creature. The Bread of Angels becomes the Bread of the poor, the wounded, the weary sinner. And yet, how often do we pass by the tabernacle unmoved? How many receive without reflection, without awe?

On this solemn day, let us recover our Eucharistic amazement. Let us kneel before the monstrance and allow our hardened hearts to melt. Let our processions not just be pageantry, but a cry of faith in a disbelieving world.

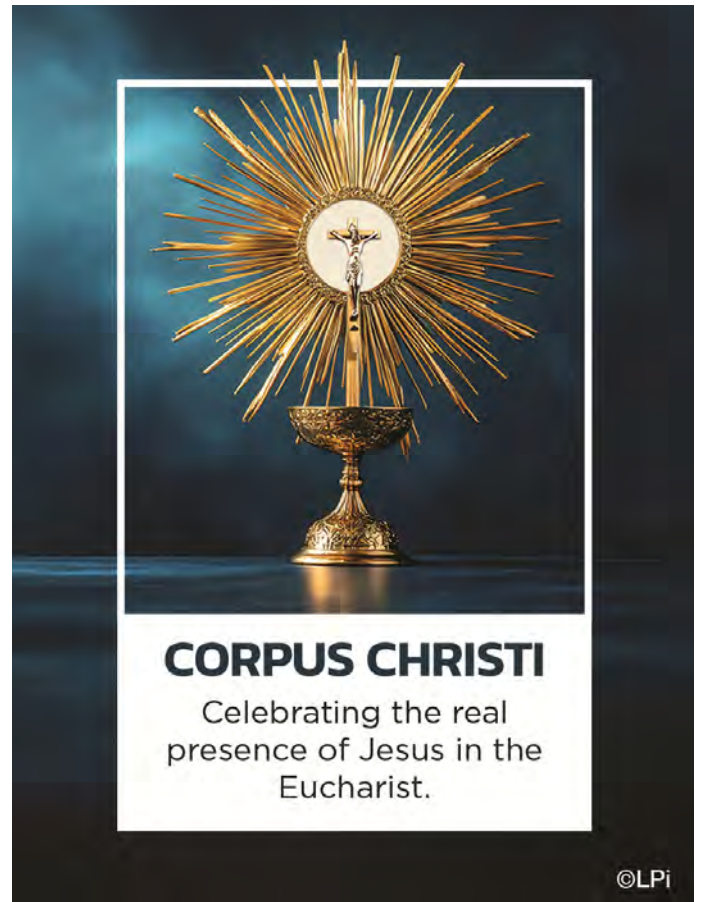
The Eucharist is the beating Heart of the Church. Without it, we die. With it, we are drawn into the very life of God.

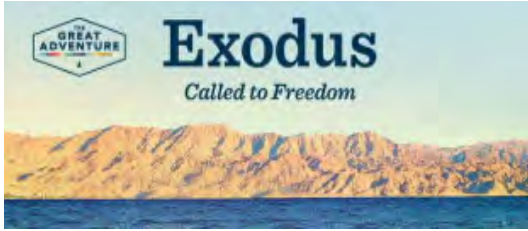

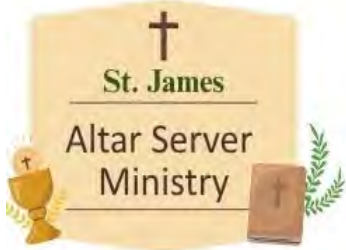

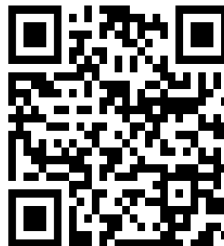

## CATHOLIC Q & A

### SERVANT OF THE SERVANTS

Coming away from the seclusion of the secret meetings of the Conclave, wherein the action of the Holy Spirit was at work, Pope Leo XIV emerged from the 15th century Sistine Chapel as the successor to St.Peter.

Within that sacred Chapel are magnificent frescoes of Genesis, Moses, The Last Judgement, and Revelation. Defining the word conclave as a secret assembly of cardinals, it can also be defined from the Latin as "conclave," meaning "with a key."

**Q:** What keys of revelatory insight have been gleaned about Pope Leo since the conclave?

**A:** The Holy Father met with members of the international media at the Vatican on May 12 where he discussed current global challenges. His comments reflect the observations of the cardinals who talk about Pope Leo's missionary identity and his capacity for authentic, active listening and humility.

"We are living in times that are difficult. They present a challenge,(these times) that we should not run away from...they demand that each of us never give in to mediocrity...the Church must face the challenges posed by the times." Here he quotes St. Augustine: "Let us live well and the times will be good. We are the times."

The Pope went on to say that our service, the words we use, and the style we adopt are crucial and can bring us out of the "Tower of Babel" in which we sometimes find ourselves.

Pope Leo's key themes of humility, empathy, and his emphasis on sharing the gifts of the Holy Spirit are there to assist in opening the doors of discernment necessary for those who choose to live well. We are the times.
