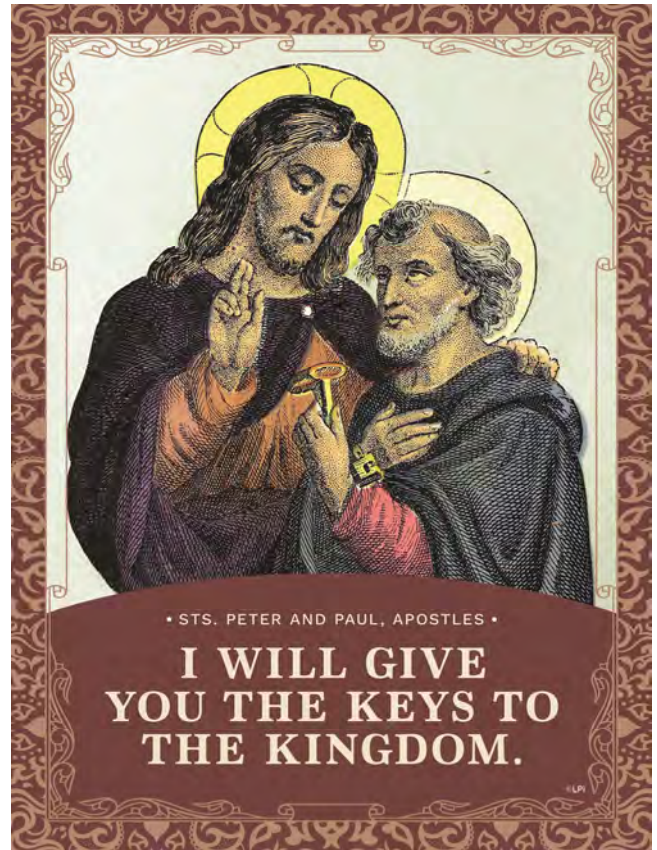

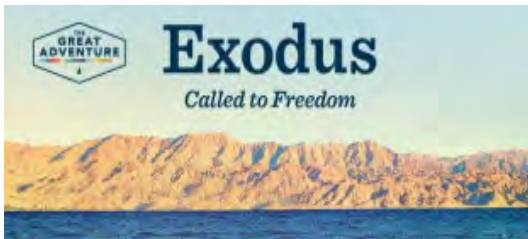
BLUE HEAVEN

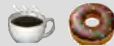

CATHOLIC Q & A

J.P. ALEGRIA

LORD, HEAR OUR PRAYER.

At Mass we listen to and receive the liturgy of the word in earnest because we are actively disposed to seeking inspiration and guidance in the ordering of our days. Additionally, we read our Bible daily, again as spiritual guidance. Scripture gives us the Book of 1 Peter and the Book of Leviticus and other citations with the spiritual admonition:

"Be holy, as your Father in heaven is Holy."

Q: How do we move closer to a more self-actualized state of holiness?

A: Pope John Paul II offered foundational first-steps:

"Holiness is first a gift of God in Baptism, when we enter into God, who is holy. It means to become like God as his image and likeness; loving as God does; following, imitating, and identifying with Jesus; living according to the Holy Spirit" In talking about the "urgency of holiness" the Holy Father touched on a clear vision of holiness along with a spiritually practical road map of sorts.

The vision: "It is necessary to rediscover the full practical significance of the universal call to holiness."

The road map: "Training in holiness calls for a Christian life distinguished above all in the art of prayer."

Our Pope Leo XIV now validates Pope John Paul II and brings forward that ancient call to holiness from his place along the line of papal succession. From the Vatican News Agency:

"The Pope emphasizes that holiness is a gift received through faith and grace, but also a journey of imitating Christ's example. He connects this to St. Peter's faith and the Church's preservation of that faith through apostolic succession."

Holiness. We were made for it and we pray for it along a continuing journey of faith.
