# PASTOR'S CORNER

Hello beautiful children of God!

In our Gospel for the 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus proclaims: *"The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few."*

These words from Jesus should both console and convict us. They console because they affirm that there are souls ready to receive the Gospel. They convict because there are too few laborers willing to go and gather them. This is not merely a vocational issue for priests or religious, it is a call to every baptized believer. You and I are meant to labor in the vineyard.

Christ sends out seventy-two disciples in pairs, a symbol of the Church's missionary nature. They are to go ahead of Him, not to replace Him, but to prepare the way for Him. And so are we! Every conversation, every act of mercy, every witness to the truth prepares hearts for a deeper encounter with Jesus Christ.

But the Lord gives a sobering warning: *"I am sending you like lambs among wolves."* The Gospel is not always welcome. The world is hostile to truth. And yet, we are not to shrink back in fear. Lambs may be weak, but we are sent by the Good Shepherd. His power is made perfect in our weakness.

Jesus tells them to carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals, which is for us a call to trust and simplicity. Too often, we think we need to have it all figured out before we evangelize. Not true. What we need is faith, obedience, and a willingness to be sent.

When the disciples return, they rejoice in their success that even the demons obeyed them. But, Jesus redirects their focus: *"Rejoice not in this, but that your names are written in heaven."* Earthly success is fleeting. Eternal life is the true prize.

The harvest is still abundant and the Lord continues to send disciples. The only question that remains is: Will you go? Trust that God will equip you for the task.

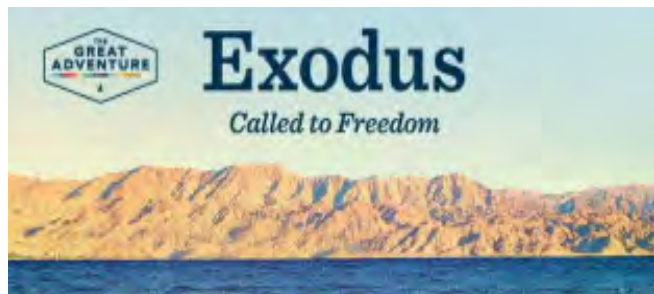

## CATHOLIC Q & A

### GOD'S HOLY WORD

**Q:** Why read the Bible?

Forty-five years ago Pope John Paul II was asked this essential question that goes to the foundational heart of some of the key tenets of catholicity, Christology, the depths of the value of holy scripture, along with greater clarity and more fullness of faith.

**A:** The Holy Father, now St. John Paul II, responded in five general paragraphs, each describing what we learn and what we know as we read the word of Jesus. Here are excerpts from that response:

- "From the Word Of Jesus we learn the very nature of God,,only Jesus, the Word Incarnate, can penetrate the essence of God..."
- "From the Word Of Jesus we know our eternal destiny: only Jesus with His divine word can assure us absolutely concerning the immortality of the soul..."
- "From the Word Of Jesus we learn..."True joy, and supreme dignity are found only in the life of grace."
- "From the Word Of Jesus we learn how we must behave...the will of God is the absolute determinant between good and evil."
- "From the Word Of Jesus we know His presence...the Church offers us the Eucharist, a mystery of faith and at the same time a supreme manifestation of love."

It was in the summer of 1980 that Pope John Paul II gave these "sound reasons for reading the Bible to encourage all Catholics to be faithful in reading God's Holy Word." Today, the USCCB teaches:

"The Church encourages Catholics to make reading the Bible part of their daily lives...inspired words...(to) grow deeper in their relationship with God and community...prayer is the beginning and the end."

As the Pope said, it's all part of "a manifestation of love."

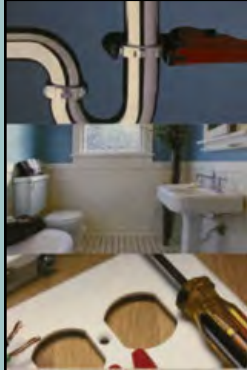

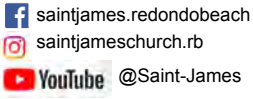

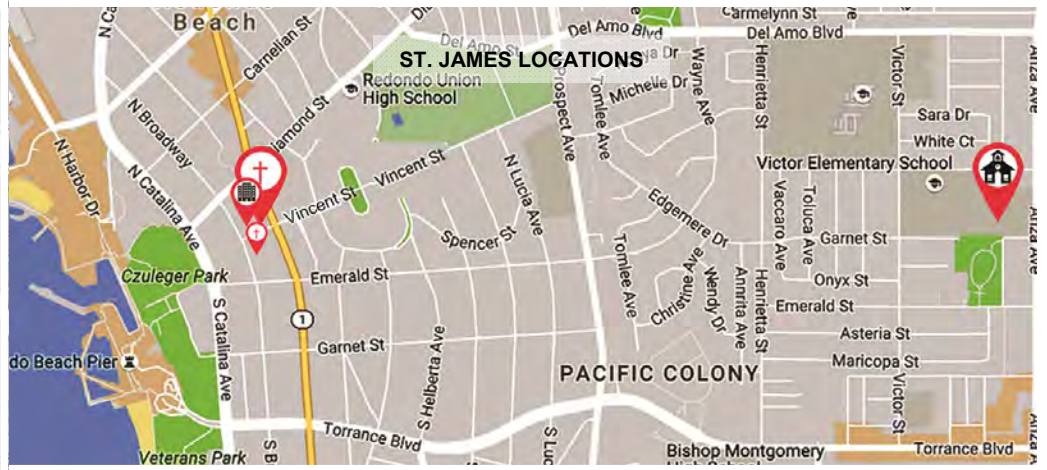
