PASTOR'S CORNER

Hello beautiful children of God!

In the parable of the Good Samaritan, our Lord does not merely tell a story, He holds up a mirror. A lawyer, seeking to justify himself, asks Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" (Lk 10:29). But Jesus does not answer the question directly. Instead, He tells a story that challenges the lawyer, and us, to stop defining "neighbor" narrowly and to start being a neighbor radically.

A man is beaten, stripped, and left for dead. The priest and the Levite, religious men by status, pass by. They likely had justifiable reasons - ritual purity laws, time constraints - but love is not about convenience. It is about interruption. The Samaritan, a despised outsider, is moved with compassion. The Greek word used, *splanchnizomai*, refers to a gut-wrenching compassion. He doesn't just feel bad, he acts. He binds wounds, spends money, alters his plans.

Jesus turns the question back: "Which of these three proved to be a neighbor?" (Lk 10:36). The lawyer answers rightly: "The one who showed mercy." And Jesus gives the command: "Go and do likewise."

Here is where the parable pierces the soul. Too often, we are the priest or the Levite, preoccupied, distant, perhaps even pious, but unmoved. We ask, "What will happen to me if I stop?" But the Samaritan asks, "What will happen to him if I don't?"

This parable is ultimately about Christ. He is the true Samaritan, despised and rejected, yet full of mercy. We are the ones beaten by sin, left half-dead on the roadside of life. He came to us, poured out His blood and oil, signs of the sacraments, and carried us to the inn of the Church.

Now He commands us: "Go and do likewise." Be Christ to others. Show mercy. Let love interrupt you. Be the neighbor you once needed, and still need, in Him.

DID YOU KNOW?

What makes a child feel safe enough to disclose abuse?

There are several factors that contribute to whether a child is comfortable disclosing abuse to an adult. Children are more likely to talk about problems when they: have access to an adult they can trust; are able to understand that what is happening to them is not normal or safe; and trust that they will be believed. Another factor that may help a child disclose abuse is when a safe adult is intentional and asks direct questions about a child's life as it communicates caring and attention to the child's life circumstances. 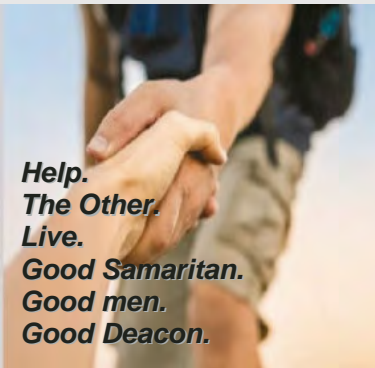

CATHOLIC Q & A

J.P. ALEGRIA

A MIRROR OF GOD'S MARVELOUS DEEDS

The Catechism describes prayers known as:

- The Prayer of the People of God; expressive and nourishing.
- Texts that deepen prayer for oneself, & in prayer for others.
- The masterwork of prayer in the Old Testament
- Prayers that are inseparably personal & communal.
- Prayers with direct simplicity in all times & conditions.
- Prayers that are a blessing on the lips of the people; the voice of the Church.

Q: What are these prayers?

A: The Catechism refers to the Psalms, the prayer of the assembly. These prayerful songs, many attributed to King David, were gradually gathered into the five books of the Psalter (or "Praises"), embracing all creation." Catechism 2597 states: "Prayed and fulfilled in Christ, the Psalms are an essential and permanent element of the prayer of the Church."

It is reported that Pope Leo XIV referenced Psalm 98 in "expressing joy at the beginning of his papacy, highlighting the marvels God has done, not just for him, but for the entire Church."

Speaking of praise, our Choir sings a hymn based on Psalms 65 and 66 called "Glory and Praise To Our God."

"Glory and praise to our God, who alone gives light to our days, many are the blessings he bears to those who trust in his ways."
